



Rules and Regulations

- The rules for all games at the National Championships shall be the latest version of FIBA playing rules.

- The following highlight some of these rules or are exceptions that shall be adopted for the purpose of the Canada Basketball National Championships:

a) Players of participating teams must be declared prior to the opening game. Only those 12 declared players may be used for the duration of the championship.

b) At the commencement of all games, participating teams must have one head coach and eight eligible players available and capable of starting play.

c) The National Anthem shall be played before all games.

d) Teams shall have two sets of uniforms of contrasting colours.

e) Teams shall use numbers 0 and 00 and from 1 to 99. Players on the same team shall not wear the same number. Teams should have extra jerseys in the case of a lost or blood stained jersey.

f) The home team in each preliminary (pool) game shall be the first team listed in the schedule of games. Teams will be re-ranked for playoffs and the home team shall be the higher ranking team.

g) The home team will wear the light-coloured jerseys; receive the bench to the left of the score table and the basket to the right of the score table.

h) Under garments are permitted as per FIBA rules with all members of the team wearing the same color. T-shirts, including compression t-shirts with sleeves are not allowed.

i) Advertising on uniforms is allowed as per FIBA rules.

j) The FIBA procedures will be followed for the pre-game warm-up. See Appendix H.

k) Half-time will be 15 minutes in length (with the option to change to 10 minutes).

l) 15U rule modifications are: (a) recommended that all players must get playing time.

m) Any other rule change or interpretation adopted by CBOC and ratified by Canada Basketball.
