Code of Conduct

During competition, we ask that athletes...

- *Show respect and regard for the interests and goals of all participants;*
- *Act on the belief that the athlete as a person is more important than the sport;*
- *Carry out its activities in a manner, which demonstrates concern for the health, well-being, protection and enhancement of all athletes and participants.*
- *Respect the officials' decisions and encourage your teammates to do the same.*
- *Act in a sportsmanlike manner and not display appearances of violence, foul language, or gestures to other athletes, officials, coaches, or spectators.*
- *Act in accordance with Canada Basketball's policies and procedures and, when applicable, additional rules as outlined by coaches or team support staff.*
- *Comply with the by-laws and policies of Canada Basketball. Copies of the by-laws and/or policies are available from your Provincial/Territorial Basketball Association, on the Canada Basketball website - www.basketball.ca or by contacting the Canada Basketball office;*
- *Be respectful and courteous towards officials, opponents, spectators, sponsors, Canada Basketball personnel, team-mates, coaching staff, support staff, peers and volunteers;*
- *Avoid any unreasonable conduct which brings Canada Basketball, its' sponsors or the sport of basketball into disrepute;*

Athletes Attire - Banquet

Acceptable Minimum: Golf Shirt / Dress Shorts or Golf Shorts / Basketball Footwear or Dress Shoes
