Dear Fairview campers and their families:

Welcome to KASPER Camp at Fairview! Thank you for trusting Schaumburg Park District with your whole world, because we understand that's what you have entrusted us with — your whole world. Here at KASPER, we believe in creating an environment for our campers that is positive, safe, creative and fun. The Fairview Team is filled with dedicated, well-trained, friendly counselors eager to provide unique, exciting and new experiences for their campers. Using small and large groups, the freedom of choice, lots of imagination and a cultivated sense of respect and belonging, we hope our campers will have the ultimate summer adventure! With this letter, we would like to cover a few details so we are all prepared and to ensure camp runs smoothly.

First Week of Camp Expectations:

- Lifeguards at the Schaumburg Park District pools will test each camper before he or she is allowed to enter the pool. If a camper does not pass the swim test, he or she will be limited to a restricted area. If you do not wish for your child to swim or take the swim test, please notify the Site Coordinator.
- Upon arrival to their first field trip day, all campers will receive a KASPER t-shirt. Campers should wear their camp shirt, along with the appropriate footwear, on all field trips days.
- Please make sure to send your camper with a nutritional and protein-filled lunch everyday to help energize them for the day's activities.
- Summer is here and with that comes hot weather and UV/UVA Rays. The staff at Fairview would like to work with you in providing the best possible sun protection for your child which includes group breaks and reapplying multiple times a day, even during overcast weather. All campers MUST have an ample amount of sunscreen available at site everyday. Without sunscreen, your camper's activities will be restricted to indoors or in a shaded area (if available) - no exceptions.

Drop Off and Pick Up:

- Drop-off starts at 7:00 am (doors will not open beforehand). Please try to arrive before 9:15 AM daily! Children must be walked into camp and signed in daily on the site IPAD.
- Pick-up is at any time during the day while campers are on-site (please refer to daily schedule). It is required that each camper is signed out at the end of every camp day. Only personnel listed in your camper's ePACT account will have access to him/her while in the care of Schaumburg Park District.
- For the safety of all, campers cannot be signed in or picked up at an offsite field trip or pool location.
