TASTING NOTES

Layered aromatics of huckleberry, blueberry, and currant mingle with a touch of complex leather and dried tobacco on the nose. The wine explodes on the palate with flavors of lush blueberry, black licorice alongside a touch of herbs and spice. This Syrah has an incredibly savory sensation with firm structure and acidity that leads into a finish of fine integrated silky tannins.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The components that make up the 2017 vintage of Syrah were harvested from early October to early November, which gave us a great range of brix and acid with which to work. The Viognier and Syrah were co-fermented alongside the Merlot in our stainless upright fermenters with PDM yeast used on all lots. We then aged the wine for 22 months in 8% new, 50% 2nd use, and 42% in neutral 59-gallon French Oak barrels.
