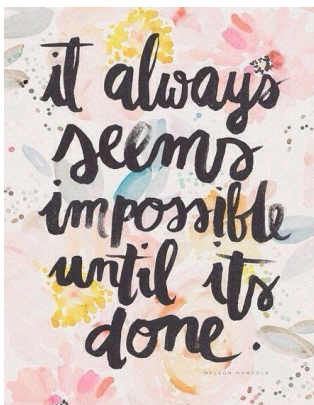

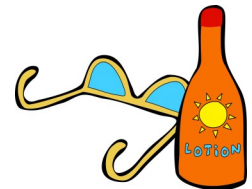


END OF SCHOOL YEAR 2022

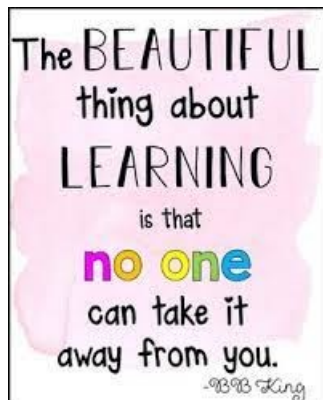
