Become a Trader

We are always on the lookout for new and interesting retail and food & beverage traders for the market.



The market is open 7 days a week.

Retail stalls are available 7 days a week and we welcome both casual or long term traders.

To trade at Old Spitalfields Market as a retail trader you must first apply to become a registered trader. You can do this HERE.

If we like your brand and products, and think they are the right fit for the market, you will be contacted by the market team and sent a registration number.

Our Food stalls are available for 5 day (weekday), 2 day (weekend) or 7 day a week traders. Food stalls are suitable for prepared food plating, but not for food cooking from scratch.
