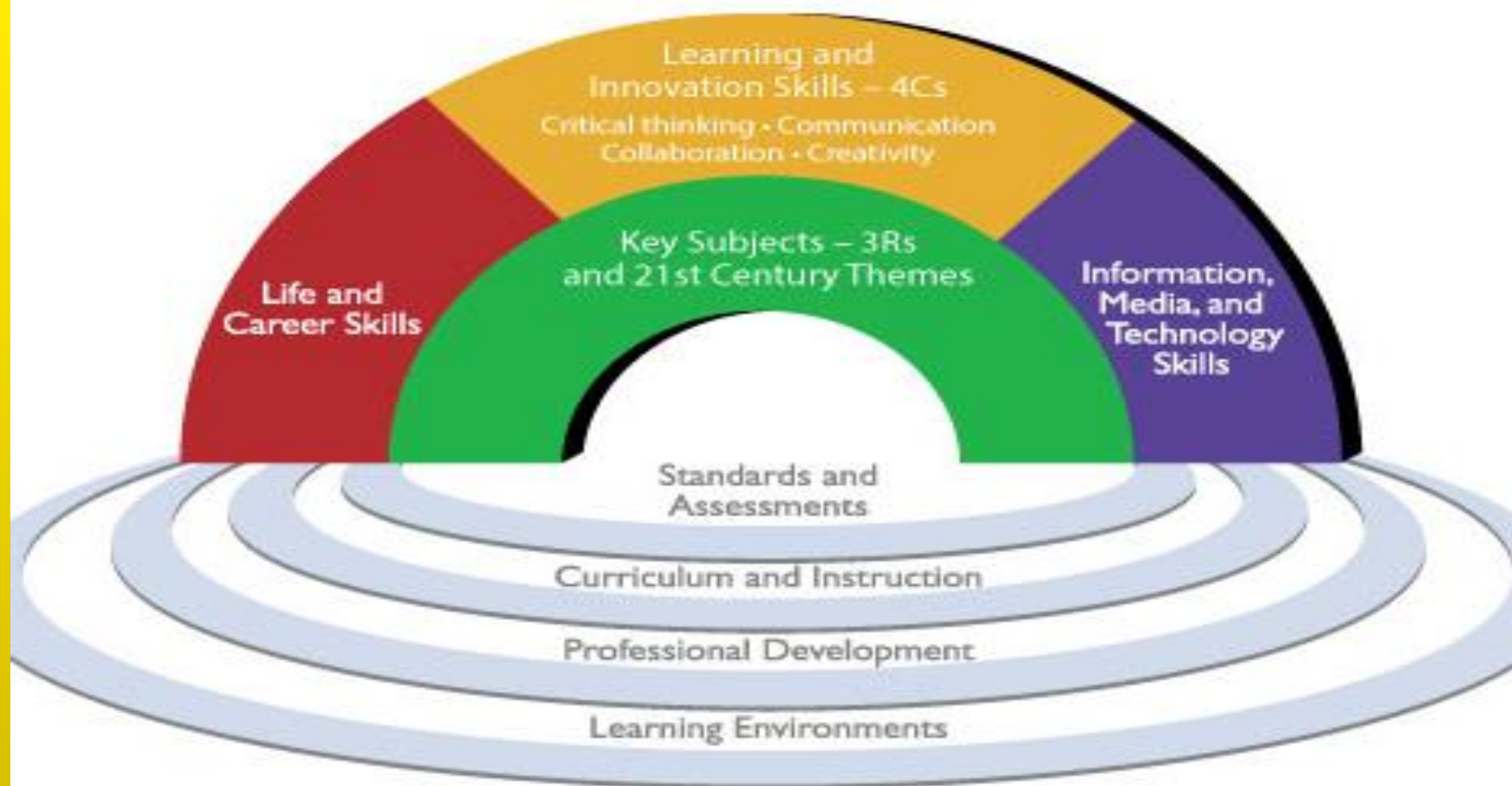

Problem-Solving on a Team

It's hard work to keep a team working well together. What would you say to or do about a team member in the following situations?

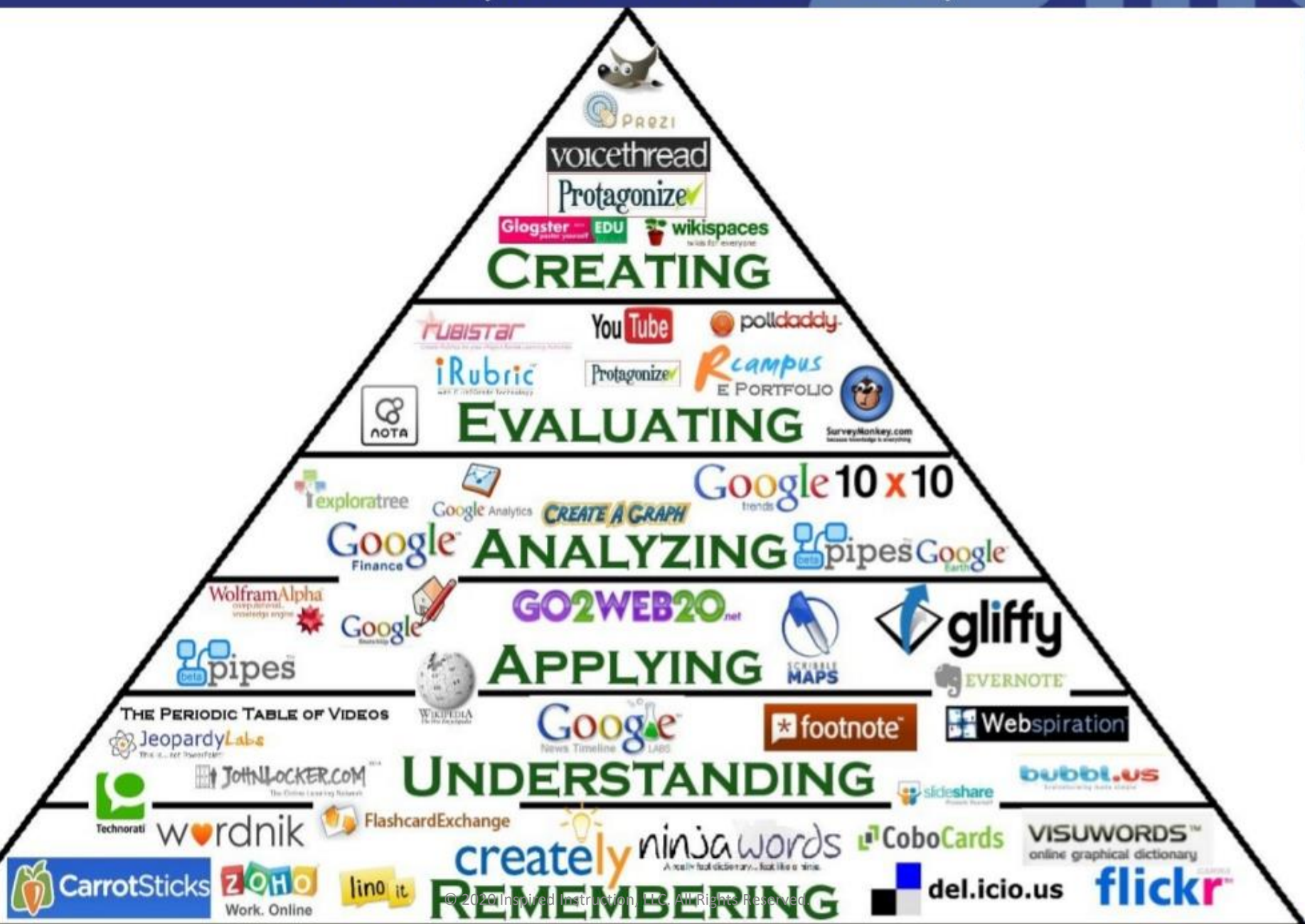
1. **Is always late.**
