A 2 <sup>nd</sup> -3 <sup>rd</sup> grade student is asymptomatic and quarantined due to COVID-19.	The teacher will provide lesson plans and gather materials within 24 hours of the student's absence.  The teacher will communicate with the parent on how best to receive the materials.	The student will complete work thoroughly and will upload pictures of their work to Seesaw daily.	The parent will help keep their student accountable to complete daily assigned work. The parent may contact the teacher via email to ask questions as needed.
A 2 <sup>nd</sup> -3 <sup>rd</sup> grade teacher is absent.	A substitute teacher will be brought in for the absence period.	The students will treat the substitute with respect and maintain a high level of care and responsibility.	Parents will continue to encourage and support their child.
The whole class or whole school is quarantined for a short period of time.	The teacher will provide lessons on Seesaw for a minimum of 3 subject areas per day and will connect with the class via Zoom. Students may receive instruction and/or assignments from either of the grade level teachers.	The students will complete daily assignments, submit work on Seesaw, and participate in class Zoom meetings.	The parent will help keep their student accountable to complete assigned work by the time they return to school. The parent may contact the teacher via email to ask questions as needed.
