

7-12 Distance Learning Plan

Interventional Distance Learning for All 7-12 Students

In a situation where distance learning needs to be implemented in response to a COVID-19 incident, a block schedule of synchronous online instruction consisting of live lessons taught with required attendance will occur. PCS teachers, working from school, if the case permits, will conduct lessons via Microsoft Teams. A schedule has been created so a seamless transition to interventional distance learning can occur during the few days needed to sanitize the school for a return to onsite learning.

Distance Learning for Quarantined 7-12 Students

Students that are being impacted by COVID-19 and are quarantined will have synchronous online instruction streamed via Microsoft Teams. Students will connect with teachers and view live lessons or receive expectations for the period.
