**PROTOCOL FOR THE ENTRY OF TRAVELLERS TO ST. VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES VIA
YACHTS – June 22 – July 31, 2020**

(18/06/2020)

AIM: The safe entry of yachts into St. Vincent and the Grenadines in a manner that reduces the risk of the importation and subsequent transmission of COVID-19 in St. Vincent and the Grenadines.

OBJECTIVES:

1. Establish the risk of the arriving yachts and passengers introducing new COVID-19 to SVG.
2. Minimized exposure of residents of SVG new COVID-19
3. Early identification of potential exposure to new COVID-19
4. Early containment of new COVID-19.

ESTABLISH RISK OF ARRIVING TRAVELER

1. Completion of forms at PoE. These PoE currently accessible are Blue Lagoon, Wallilabou and Port Kingstown.

QUARANTINE REQUIREMENTS:

- All arriving yachts will request permission for entry by email to coronavirustaskforcesvg@gmail.com.

- An online risk assessment form must be completed prior to arrival
- Once accepted for entry, after initial screening, yachts will proceed to designated area(s) for on-vessel quarantine
- Mooring at designated areas* will be at the cost of the yacht.
- Those who opt for SVG COVID-19 PCR testing will remain onboard until results are received. If negative, no further quarantine will be required. If positive, they will be isolated at a government facility for care and treatment. Both testing and isolation will be at the cost of the yachts.
