A RESOLUTION TO REMOVE OFFENDING RUINS, WRECKAGE OR DEBRIS FROM PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Village of Williamsburg has authority to determine whether ruins, rubbish, wreckage, or debris located on any premise within the Village of Williamsburg menaces the public comfort, health, peace or safety and should be removed from the premises. See NMSA 1978, 3-18-5 (1977);

WHEREAS, Roger Norden Sr. and Carol Norden Sr. owns property within the Village of Williamsburg located at 117 Hyde Ave.;

WHEREAS, the above described property contains a house and shed that does not conform to ordinances governing Dangerous and Unsafe Structures. In addition the property is covered with debris and weeds. These conditions are a menace to the comfort, health, peace and safety of the citizens of the Village of Williamsburg;

WHEREAS, the owner, occupant, or agent of the premises shall have ten (10) days from the date this resolution is served or posted on the property to remove the Dangerous and Unsafe Structures and clean up the property, or file a written objection with the Village Clerk asking for a hearing before the governing body of the Village of Williamsburg.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Village of Williamsburg will remove the offending structures, debris and weeds should Roger Norden Sr. and Carol Norden Sr., their agent, or the resident of the property, if any, fail to remove the dangerous and unsafe structures and clean up the property or request a hearing within ten (10) days of the date this Resolution is posted on the offending property.
