Ordinance # 10-26-16-17

An Ordinance Regulating the Reimbursement of All Travel, Meal, and Lodging Expenses of Officers and Employees of the Roselle Park District in Accordance with the Local Government Travel Expense Control Act (P.A 099-0604)

WHEREAS, Roselle Park District (“Park District”) is an Illinois park district and non-home rule unit of local government duly organized and operating pursuant to the Illinois Park District Code (70 ILCS 1205/1-1, *et seq.*); and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly recently enacted Public Act 99-0604, known as the Local Government Travel Expense Control Act (“Act”), which takes effect on January 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires all non-home rule units of local government to adopt regulations governing, among other things, the reimbursement of all travel, meal, and lodging expenses of officers and employees of the Park District; and

WHEREAS, the Park District intends to comply with the requirements of said Act by passage of this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Roselle Park District, DuPage County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby determined to be true and correct and are incorporated and made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein.
