Firefighters		A firefighter is a person whose job is to put out fires.
Police Officers		A police officer a person whose job is to enforce laws, investigate crimes and make arrests.
Doctors and Nurses		A doctor is a person who is qualified to treat people who are ill. A nurse is a person trained to care for the sick especially in a hospital.
Paramedics		A paramedic is a person trained to give emergency medical care to people who are seriously ill before they are taken to hospital.
Dentists		A dentist is a person who is qualified to treat diseases and other conditions that affect the teeth and gums.
Postal Workers		A postal worker is a person who works for Royal Mail and delivers letters and parcels.

Emergency Vehicles

Fire Engine		A fire engine is a large vehicle that carries firefighters and their equipment to a fire. It carries a ladder, hoses, water and fire extinguishers.
Police Car/helicopter/ motorcycle boat/ horse		These are different ways of transport used by police officers to patrol the streets and water ways and to respond to incidents and emergencies.
Ambulance/Air Ambulance		These are vehicles equipped for taking sick or injured people to and from hospital, especially in emergencies.
Post Van/ Bicycle		These are vehicles that are used by postal workers to transport letters and parcels.

Fun Fact

Did you know that more than 500 years ago King Henry VIII started a postal service for members of royal families? More than 100 years later, it became a public service to be used by everyone.

At first, Post-boys carried mail on horseback between towns but later on they used horse-drawn coaches with Royal Mail livery to transport post.
