

Covid-19 Renter & Facility Guidelines:

COVID-19 Guidelines for all users of Clauss Recreation Center

- All renters must familiarize themselves with the Restore Illinois Phase 4 Guidelines and distribute the guidelines to all guests/attendees, and any other parties who will be on-site at the rental. Renter is responsible for enforcing these guidelines among any guests/attendees and any other parties.
- If any guests/rental attendees, and any other parties has tested positive for COVID-19 or experienced any of the symptoms: fever over 100.3, cough, vomiting, sore throat, chills, shortness of breath, or other cold and flu symptoms within the past 14 days, they should not enter the facility.
- Any individual who tests positive for COVID-19 between 1 and 14 days after visiting the facility should immediately notify the rental contact person and the Roselle Park District Recreation Manager, Dana Colantuono at dcolantuono@rparks.org.

Best practices for all users of Roselle Park District facilities

- Social distancing of at least 6 feet should be practiced as much as possible.
- Masks are always required to be worn, except while eating or drinking.
- Renters are encouraged to disinfect surface areas such as chairs, tabletops, door handles, etc.
- Renters are encouraged to bring their own water; water fountains are not available.
- Hand sanitizer is available for public use at entry doors of the facilities, and we ask that as a courtesy to all patrons, everyone who enters the building sanitize their hands.
- Restrooms are available on the main floor.
