

COVID-19 UPDATE TIER 2 PHASE 4 MITIGATION

The safety of our program patrons, fitness members, and staff remains to be our utmost importance as we enter Tier 2 of the Phase 4 Mitigation. The Roselle Park District has always been dedicated to offering a healthy way of life for our customers, and through careful planning and cleaning, we will continue to make changes to our programs and facilities to make sure we comply with the current guidelines. The Roselle Park District team has and will continue to increase efforts to clean and sanitize our facilities and program areas in accordance with the CDC guidelines. We encourage and promote social distancing to ensure the health and safety to all.

Tier 2 Phase 4 Mitigation begins on Wednesday, November 11, 2020.

Program Spectators: (Dance, Youth Sports, Music, etc.):

- To comply with the Tier 2 Phase 4 Mitigation plan the Roselle Park District will no longer permit spectators.
- Due to the nature of our youth programs, we know many of our participants may require support and/or assistance. Therefore, one parent/guardian will be permitted to escort the participant into the facility to provide support. Once your child is in their program, then you will have to return to your car until then of their program.
- If your child does not require any support as outlined above, we kindly ask you drop off your child and wait in your car for the duration of the scheduled program time.

Fitness Center:

- Face coverings are required in the fitness center anytime you are not working out and/or you are going from station to station.

School Based Programs:

- School based programs are park district programs that are held on site at school. (Club Kids, Teacher Childcare or Wildcat Care).
- All school-based programs will be limited to 10 or fewer in each group.

Room Rentals:

- All room rentals will be limited to 10 people or fewer.

Special Events:

- All special events are limited to 10 people or fewer at any given time.
- All special events scheduled during this time will be following the current guidelines. *These guidelines may change prior to each event and we will make the appropriate changes before those events start.*

COVID-19 Guidelines:

- All programs and events will follow current guidelines.
- Masks are required unless otherwise noted.
- Social distancing will be practiced.
