

3 on 3 Youth Basketball Tournament Rules 2023

All participants will adhere to these amended house rules.

- 1. Each team may consist of 3 to 5 players (3 players on the court and 2 substitutes).
- 2. Team that wins the coin toss decides whether they want ball to start game.
- 3. Each game will be up to 15 points or 15 minutes long. Does not have to win by 2 points can win by 1 point.
- 4. In the event of a tie after playing time, an extra 1-minute period will be played. The first to score a point in overtime wins the game. Possession alternates each overtime period.
- 5. Baskets are worth 1 point and baskets made from behind the take-back line are worth 2 points.
- 6. Take-back line will be defined on the court.
- 7. After a basket, the team scored upon (non-scoring team) will put the ball in play behind the take-back line.
- 8. On defensive rebounds or steals, players must return the ball by dribble or pass across the take back line before a basket may be attempted. Once across the line, they do not have to pass the ball before shooting. Offensive rebounds does not require the team to go across the take-back line.
- 9. Fouls will be called by the court monitor/referee. A foul called in the act of shooting or non-shooting will result in a free-throw worth 1 point. Offensive fouls will result in a change of possession.
- 10. After a jump ball situation, the defensive team receives the ball.
- 11. 30 second shot clock.
- 12. Substitutions may be made after a basket or an out of bounds play.
- 13. Each team is only allowed one 45-second timeout.
- 14. 3 Games Guaranteed
- 15. Standings of teams
 - a. Most Wins
 - b. Head-to-Head
