Formerly called the New York State Trudeau Society, NYSTS is named after Edward Livingston Trudeau (1845-1915), for whom a lectureship at this annual meeting is named. The first American investigator to culture the *tubercle bacillus*, the causative agent for tuberculosis, he founded Adirondack Cottage Sanitarium at Saranac Lake, NY in 1884 based on his own open air cure of tuberculosis.
