BALTIMORE~ 6 Hours includes Bus & Guide Tour #1 Ports, Sports, and Neighborhoods

Your students will enjoy a walking and driving tour of favorite Baltimore neighborhoods like Little Italy, Fells Point, the Inner Harbor, Harbor East, Federal Hill and more as time permits. Stop at Camden Yards and Fort McHenry. *From \$21/pp.*

Tour #2 Our Wonderful Waterfront STEM Tour

Meet Mr. Trashwheel, learn of oyster farming and the wetlands-all at the Inner Harbor. Eat your lunch and play in Pierce's Park. Choose an activity at the Museum of Industry, a visit to the Maryland Science Center with Scavenger Hunt or a cruise. *From \$26/St.*

Tour #3 Pirates and Patriots, Flags and A Fort ~ War of 1812 Tour

Step back in time as you visit Fells Point, Federal Hill, the Flag House, and Fort McHenry and hear stories of the bravery of Baltimoreans. *From \$28/student.*

Tour #4 In the Footsteps of Frederick, Harriet, Thurgood & Carmelo

Visit Fells Point to learn of Frederick Douglass, Harriet Tubman, and Isaac Myers. See the Maritime Museum here. See the houses owned by Frederick Douglass. Tour the Lewis Museum, see the statue of Thurgood Marshall. Hear the stories of Mother Mary Lange, Eubie Blake, Frank Robinson, Carmelo Anthony, Dr. Ben Carson. Be inspired by their words and deeds. *From \$29/student.*



Tour #5 I Spy A Star-Spangled City

Your students will search for important places and symbols related to our National Anthem. They will visit Fort McHenry, Fells Point, Federal Hill, and the Flag House. Enjoy lunch and take a special one-hour National Anthem Cruise. *From* \$37/student; \$40/adult. Fee waiver required at the Fort.



ANNAPOLIS~ 6 Hours includes Bus & Guide Tour #1 Capitals, Colleges and Cool Buildings

Your students will experience Annapolis past & present in this fun, guided walking tour. This tour features the State House, St. John's College, Maryland Ave. Houses and US Naval Academy. Lunch is at the City Dock. *From \$26/person*

Tour #2 Capitals, Colleges, Cool Buildings, and a Cruise

Explore the preserved city of Annapolis and the United States Naval Academy on this walking tour. Eat your lunch while enjoying a 40-minute narrated cruise on the Severn. *From \$32/student and \$36/adult.*



PHILADELPHIA~ 9 Hours includes Coach & Guide Tour #1 In the Footsteps of Patriots with time for Cheesesteaks Your students will walk the "most historic square mile in America" as they learn what life was like for a child of the Revolution. They will see Independence Hall, Liberty Bell, Betsy Ross House, Christ Church, Elfreth's Alley, as time permits. From \$45/person. To Visit Christ Church, or Betsy Ross House, add \$3/person/site.

Tour #2 Franklin's World- 9 Hours

A unique opportunity to explore Ben Franklin's influence on Philadelphia and the world. Students will visit the Franklin Institute and take a walking tour of Philadelphia to trace the footsteps of Franklin. Ample time is given for cheese steaks or souvenir shopping. *From \$59/person*

Tour #3 From Revolution to Constitution ~ A Turnkey Tour- 9 Hours

This tour includes admission to the Museum of the American Revolution and the National Constitution Center. Arrangements are made for students to eat lunch and have time for shopping. *From \$59/person.*

WASHINGTON, DC~ 7 Hrs. includes Coach & Guide Tour #1 Three Branches of Government & a Smithsonian

Your students will enjoy a driving tour and then see the Capitol and White House while learning about the three branches of government. Lunch is at the Lincoln, Viet Nam and Korean Memorials. Then visit one of the Smithsonian Museums or the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial. *From \$40/person*

Tour #2 Dr. King's DC Tour – 8 Hours

Your students will tour Washington and see the National Museum of African American History, Lincoln Park, and the Mary McCleod Bethune Statue, a Downtown Driving tour, and a visit to Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial and the Lincoln Memorial. *From* \$45/person

Tour #3 Arlington National Cemetery 8 Hours

Your students will experience the solemn Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Kennedy Graves, the Challenger Memorial and more. They will then have time at the Lincoln and Vietnam Memorials for lunch on own before choosing one Smithsonian Museum to explore. *From \$45/person*

MT. VERNON~ 7 Hrs includes Coach, Escort From \$47/student; \$49/adult

Students will enjoy a full day visiting the home and estate of George and Martha Washington as well as a working farm, gardens, outbuildings, dock, burial grounds and Visitor Center. Food court is available or bring lunch & eat lunch on the coach.



GETTYSBURG~ 8 Hrs. includes Coach & Guide From \$55 pp

Your students will tour the new Visitor Center, see the Cyclorama presentation, the film and enjoy the exhibits. Brown bag lunch is on your own. Then take a 2-hour battlefield tour with a licensed battlefield guide. **Option:** Lunch at the historic Dobbin House which was part of the Underground Railroad.



LANCASTER~ 7 Hrs. Includes Bus, Guide, Sites From

\$47/St. Our Amish neighbors in Lancaster live in a culture that is simple and set apart from the world your students know. Your students will explore life on an Amish Farm. Then visit a Farmer's Market or the Kitchen Kettle Village. Students will see the countryside on a driving tour. Finally, all will enjoy a tour and tasting at the Herr's Snack Factory.



STATUE OF LIBERTY & ELLIS ISLAND~ 13 Hrs. Includes Bus, Tour Escort, Ferry Ticket From \$82/student

Your students will view "Island of Hope, Island of Tears," and enjoy an orientation prior to arriving at Liberty Park, NJ. Ample time is provided at Ellis Island to understand the immigrant experience and at the Statue with optional access to pedestal. Turnpike stop for dinner on own.

TOUR COST ~ We offer an all-inclusive pricing structure for your convenience. Trips involving school buses are based on 35 or more paying while tours with coaches are based on 40 or more paying/vehicle. Any adults wishing to drive on their own will be charged the full price if all buses are not completely filled.

COMPLIMENTARY POLICY ~ Teachers are always our guests. As a rule, there is one complimentary for every 20 paid passengers once your minimums are reached. Teachers receive the first comps.

DRIVER & GUIDE GRATUITIES ~ These are not included in your costs and are at your discretion. For your convenience, we are happy to include them in your pricing. Just let us know.

DEPOSITS ~ A deposit of \$100/school bus is required. A deposit of \$150/ coach is required for tours without other fees or \$200 or more/coach for tours with tickets like Independence Hall, etc.

FINAL PAYMENT ~ The date for the final payment is stated on the contract. For purchase orders, please contact us.

REFUNDS ~ A student or chaperone on a day trip without tickets may receive a partial refund if we have been notified 48 hours before the day of the tour. On overnight tours, refunds will be decided on a case-by-case basis.

Please Note: For safety reasons, babies, toddlers, and children under school age are not permitted to accompany a chaperone.
