

Summary of Academic Programme at GIIS Tokyo

CBSE



The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) is a renowned education system that prepares students from classes 1 to 12 for competitive examinations while facilitating entry into the world's leading universities. This pedagogical approach to holistic education enables students to focus effectively on academics, as well as pursue their interests in sports and extracurricular activities.

The CBSE Curriculum

The interdisciplinary teaching at GIIS gives students a powerful opportunity to apply knowledge, principles, and values to more than one academic subject simultaneously. CBSE's global curriculum comprises built-in activities and exercises which promote cross-curricular learning. This approach supports two important GIIS goals: the ability to apply knowledge effectively in a variety of contexts and to engage in higher-level reasoning skills. Teachers, meanwhile, leverage this method into an enriched learning experience by helping students more easily connect with the material.

In addition to learning how to surmount demanding academic rigours, students also learn how to apply skills learned in the classroom to real-world challenges. The subjects covered are Languages, Science, Mathematics, Social Science and ICT.

CBSE Assessments and Outcomes

As with all of our other curriculum offerings, academics are at the forefront of the CBSE Programme. This commitment is exemplified by the consistently outstanding test scores of our students in both Class 10 and Class 12 in CBSE Board Examinations.



Cambridge Programme



Our campus offers a range of multiple international curricula to students. They get a choice of International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (Grades 1~ 5), Cambridge Lower Secondary Programme (Grades 6 ~ 8), Cambridge IGCSE (Grades 9 and 10), and International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP).

CLSP and IGCSE Programme

One of the curricula options available in secondary education with GIIS is the Cambridge Lower Secondary Programme (CLSP). The CLSP sharpens the knowledge and immaculate skills of students studying in 6th, 7th, and 8th grade (Key Stage 3). This curriculum identifies the exceptional skills required in learning objectives for English, Maths, Science and allows the facilitators to model the curriculum on how the students want to learn. GIIS aims at providing the best learning journey for Cambridge students to pursue higher qualifications like IGCSE and choose the right career paths.

The Cambridge International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) curriculum is recognized as the world's most exemplary education curriculum to transform 14-16 years old students into well-rounded individuals. IGCSE schools extend the limits for student-centered learning, and they create a flexible environment for students to develop intellectual inquiry and communication skills. The two-year course covers every aspect of student development, and they will also come across several cross-cultural perspectives.

IGCSE Subjects offered at GIIS, Tokyo

First Language English, Second Language English, Foreign Language French, Hindi as a second, Japanese, Extended Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Information & Communication Technology, Business Studies, Economics, History, Global Perspectives.

Cambridge Assessment Criteria

IGCSE is a two-year course and Cambridge IGCSE assessment takes place at the end of the course and can include written, oral, coursework, and practical assessment. These assessments can provide valuable evidence of a student's achievement. It also provides focus, pace, motivation, and challenge to learners during a one- or two-year course. Grades are benchmarked using eight internationally recognised grades, A* to G, which have clear guidelines to explain the standard of achievement for each grade.

Cambridge IGCSE curriculum

The Cambridge IGCSE subjects are grouped into five curriculum areas:



Group I: Languages



Group II: Humanities and Social Sciences



Group III: Sciences



Group IV: Mathematics



Group V: Creative and Professional

Learners must take two different languages from Group I, and one subject from each of Groups II, III, IV, and V. The seventh subject can be taken from any of the five subject groups.



International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme









The IB Primary Years Programme (IBPYP) is an exemplary education programme developed by the International Baccalaureate for students in the age group of 5-12 years. The IB PYP program fosters students with excellent skills, develops them as caring and active participants in the learning journey for a lifetime. Our teachers guide students through the inquiry based, transdisciplinary learning that enhances their knowledge and builds critical and conceptual thinking capabilities.

The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme (DP) is an assessed programme for students aged 16 to 19. It is respected by leading universities across the globe. The Diploma Programme (DP) aims to develop students who have excellent breadth and depth of knowledge – students who flourish physically, intellectually, emotionally, and ethically. The DP is an academically challenging and balanced programme of education. It addresses the intellectual, social, emotional, and physical well-being of students, and is respected by universities across the globe.

Beginning in September 2020, GIIS Tokyo offers the internationally recognized IB Diploma Programme intending to nurture GIIS' future global leaders. The school hopes that the programme will further promote active learning and insightful thinking in our students.

IBDP courses/curricula

As of date GIIS Tokyo students have choices of subjects ranging from English Language and Literature, Japanese B, French B, French ab initio, Japanese ab initio, Economics, Information Technology in a Global Society (ITGS), Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Computer Science, Mathematics: applications and interpretation and Mathematics: analysis and approaches along with three core elements of IB: Theory of knowledge (TOK), The Extended Essay (EE), and Creativity, Activity,

Academic Support Activities at GIIS Tokyo



Field trips / Overseas Service-Learning Trips

To strengthen opportunities and to learn beyond the confines of the classroom, while exploring new areas of learning, regular field trips are arranged for all levels.



External Examinations

The school works in conjunction with eminent national and international bodies such as International Math Olympiad, National Science Olympiad, ICAS (UNSW), Kanji Kantei to facilitate student participation in various exams as per their choice and interest.



HeyMath

A world-class e-learning programme for Mathematics. It helps students to hone logical thinking and problem-solving skills. It primarily focuses on self-learning mechanisms for students through the e-learning module, e-worksheets for additional reinforcement, and e-assessments for diagnostic testing and identifying students' learning outcomes and gaps.



Detailed Assessment (DA)

An online tool for assessing topics in Science, Mathematics, and English. A topic-wise diagnostic tool, DA aims to assess the level of comprehension of a topic among students and provide immediate feedback to teachers to proactively improve student performance.



Debates

School regularly participates in debate programs conducted by local schools and debating championships held by Julia Gabriel group and others.



Project Exhibition

Students are assigned different topics and specific projects for each level during school holidays and they are given opportunities to exhibit their projects.



Literary & Book week

School organises language week for all levels to improve oral/conversational skills of students in the second language. Some of the activities conducted during the second language period are drama, skit, and poem recitation. School also organises a book week for all levels to promote reading habits.



Intra-school and Inter-school Events

Students at all levels are encouraged to participate in all school events. We believe that no child should be left behind and hence offer opportunities for participation in Annual Day celebrations, Sports day, Literary Week, and similar programmes, along with weekly House activities.
