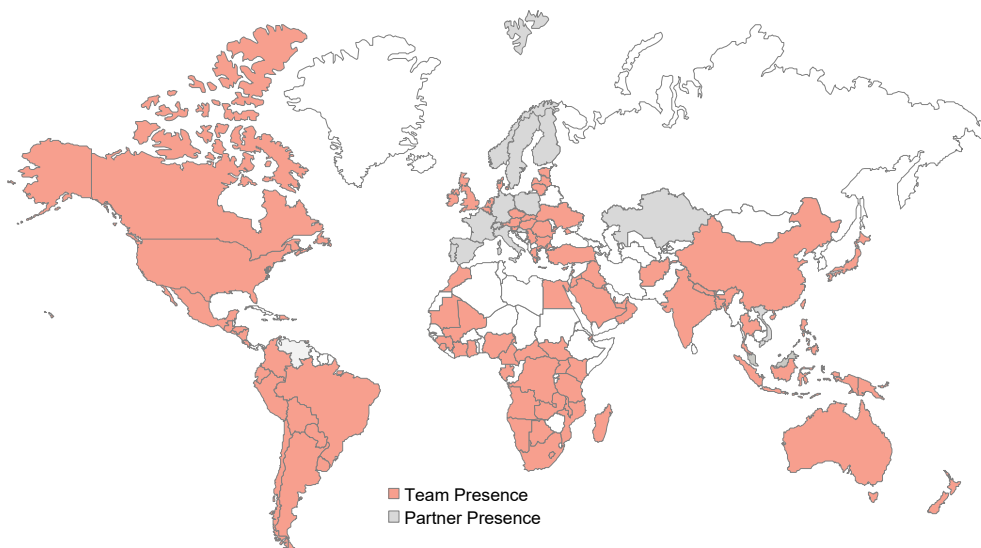

*Contracts whose value is at or below the “competitive threshold” may generally be awarded on a sole-source basis, without the competition among 8(a) firms that would result if the contract were set aside. Tribal Enterprises have additional privileges and may receive a sole source contract up to \$22 million, and with proper justification, up to \$100 million. A Tribally owned 8(a) certified company also has exemption from competitive thresholds; there is no dollar threshold on sole source 8(a) contracts (Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 13 Section 124.506.5(b) Exemption from competitive thresholds for participants owned by Indian Tribes, ANCs and NHOs)).
