



## Long-Term History Substitute Teacher

### Overview

St. Luke's Episcopal School is seeking a dynamic, innovative History Teacher to serve as a long-term substitute on the Upper Elementary/Intermediate Level team. **This is a temporary assignment that could start in mid-March, 2021, and go through May 2021\*.**

### Responsibilities

The long-term substitute will assist and teach 4<sup>th</sup> (Early US/Texas) and 5<sup>th</sup> (Geography/Early Civilizations) Grade history and a Technology/Media class. The position includes responsibility for a homeroom group, providing instruction for five sections of students, and supervisory responsibilities as requested.

The school day begins at 7:30 a.m. and concludes at 4:00 p.m.

- Background in the general history
- A minimum of three years of experience teaching at the upper elementary/intermediate School level, with proven mastery in effectively delivering content

- Passion for and experience with integrating technology into the curriculum
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
