Position Summary:

The Products Management group, reporting to the Business Unit Director, is responsible for managing the Adacel Product Development Lifecycle, establishing and maintaining the product roadmaps in accordance with the company strategy and managing the R&D pipeline.

The Product Owner II manages the development of one or multiple existing complex Product(s) and/or component(s) under their responsibility. He/she acts as the customers' advocate articulating the user's needs internally and translate business requirements into user stories and system requirements for the development teams to implement. The Product Owner defines the overall Product vision, roadmap, and priorities, which he communicates to stakeholders throughout the project.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Product Development

- Plan and prioritizes R&D, customer, and internal development backlog that will serve as the primary input to Adacel's Dynamic Iterative Development cycle.
- Sits on project CCB to set development items severity and priority only the Product Owner can change the order in the overall product backlog.
- Support the Product Specialist to ensure the developed solution meets product use cases/requirements; maybe required to investigate deficiencies reported by the users.
- Works closely with Product Specialist, System Engineer and Solutions Architect, to identify the most cost-effective solutions.

Requirements Management

- Understands and details in White Papers the customer requirements; act as the customers' advocate articulating the end user's needs.
- Work with Product Specialist's to identify, clarify and write product functional system requirements user stories based on Behavior Driven Design (BDD) acceptance criteria.
- Manages and structures these functional requirements in our requirements management tool (Contour).



Bid/Proposal Support

- Develop and maintain the product specification documents.
- Establish the product compliancy to the customer requirements.
- Work with Solutions Architect and System Engineer in the development of the DTW solution and identification of any delta development.
- Write functional requirements for any features/functionality requiring new development to support estimating effort.
- Participate in the writing of our technical proposal response.
- Participate and assist in BD Marketing and Sales efforts as required:
 - o Lead proof of concept and/or prototype plans;
 - o Demonstrate product capabilities to potential customers;
 - o Participate in conferences and exhibits.
- Provides inputs/support to technical publication group.

Roadmap

- Periodically update and maintain the product roadmaps in accordance with the future business opportunities, product improvement priorities and company's strategic objectives.
- Participate in R&D planning process for assigned products and/or components.
- Proactively research and keep informed of market evolution, regulation, and tendencies.
- Assess current competitor offerings and seek opportunities for differentiation.
- Communicates these roadmaps internally to ensure buy in from all stakeholders and externally.
- Develop business cases for new products and improvement to existing products.
- Support, make or buy decisions.
