Schedule of Events / Match Details

All non shooting activities will generally be held in the big tent. The west end are stages 1-5 and the east end stages 6-10.

Friday June 4th

- Noon to 5pm Registration
- RV parking all day
- Informal warmup shooting (if you have primers for that) – no shooting match stages
- Posse marshal walkthrough 4:30pm
- Burgers and hotdogs at 5pm

Saturday June 5th

- 7:30am Registration and packet pickup begins
- 8am posse marshal walkthrough if necessary for those that missed it Friday
- 9am mandatory shooter safety meeting
- 9:15am shoot first five stages
- Lunch provided on the range
- Side matches after lunch 2pm-4pm

Sunday June 6th

- 8am cowboy church
- 9am shoot 5 stages – go straight to your first stage
- Lunch provided after match
- Awards to immediately follow lunch

Round Count for main match:

- Pistol 100 rounds

- Shotgun approximately 50

Stages

Stage 1 - Hairtrigger's Corn Dodgers

10 Rifle staged anywhere safely

10 Pistols Holstered

4+ Shotgun staged anywhere safely

Line: "All my EX's live in Texas"

Starting position: Hands at sides, position of choice

Order: Shooters choice, rifle not last

ATB:

Pistols: from the left side of the post, engage each target one time with the tenth round on target of choice

Rifle: from the table opening, repeat pistol instructions

Shotgun: from the right side of the right post, engage shotgun knock downs until down

Stage 2 - Schweddy Balls Bar and Grill

10 Rifle staged on the bar

10 Pistols Holstered

4+ Shotgun in Hand

Line: "You like a good saloon?"

Starting position: Shotgun in hand at door or window

Order: Start with shotgun, do not end with rifle.

ATB:

Shotgun: engage 2 knock downs from the doorway and two knock downs from the window.

Rifle and pistol: engage the appropriate targets in a 2-1-2 sweep and then repeat starting on either end

Stage Notes: Shotgun may be first and last, knock downs may be made up from any position safely; shotgun in hand, other hand may be on shells in belt

PS: the theme of this stage was inspired by an appetizer or snack dish consisting of sausage balls. When served on the TTH range, condensation would form in the serving container, thus sweaty balls. As a reminder, we are a family friendly range.

Stage 3 – Ruidoso’s Buck Board Service

10 Rifle staged on back of wagon

4+ Shotgun staged in the middle of the wagon

10 Pistols staged on the horse

Line: “If it weren’t for women, none of us would be here”

Starting position: Back of the wagon hands at your side

Order: Rifle, shotgun, pistol

ATB:

Rifle: engage rifle targets in a Nevada sweep double tapping the end targets

For example 11-2-3-44-3-2-11

Shotgun: engage knock downs until down

Pistols: repeat rifle instructions

Notes: If you can reach it, you can shoot it

Stage 4 - Lethal Larry's Cat Wagon

10 Rifle staged on the wagon

10 Pistols Holstered

4+ Shotgun staged on the wagon

Line: "I do not fear the skunk, I simply do not care for its odor"

Starting position: Hands on gun or guns of choice; long guns must be flat on table, pistols must be fully holstered.

Order: Shooter's choice, rifle cannot be last.

Pistols: engage pistol targets in 3-4-3 sweep starting on either end

Rifle: repeat pistol instructions on rifle targets

Shotgun: from right side of right post, engage knock downs until down

Stage 5 - Gunsmoke Gunshop

10 Rifle staged in right window

10 Pistols holstered

4+ Shotgun staged in the left window

Line: "Yes, we have no primers"

Line: "Out here, we value a spirited women almost as much as a spirited horse"

Starting position: Rifle or Shotgun in hands

Order: Rifle, shotgun pistol or shotgun, rifle, pistol

ATB: With gun of choice, rifle or shotgun.

Rifle: starting on either target engage targets in an alternating progressive sweep, 1-22-333-4444

Shotgun: engage knock downs until down

Pistols: from doorway repeat rifle instructions

Notes: Gun order will be rifle, shotgun, pistol or shotgun, rifle, pistol. Pistol must be last.

Stage 6 - The Freight Office

10 Rifle staged in left window

10 Pistol Holstered

4+ Shotgun staged in right window

Line: "Why do women always want to change a man?"

Starting position: Left window with hands on staged rifle

Order: Rifle, pistol, shotgun

ATB:

Rifle: engage rifle targets in a 1-2-4-2-1 sweep starting from either end.

Pistols: from crate engage pistol targets using the same instructions as the rifle.

Shotgun: from right window engage knock downs until down.

Note: Hands on staged rifle means rifle staged flat on table.

Order: Rifle, pistol, shotgun

Stage 7 - Texas Star Bank

4+ Shotgun staged on the Safe

10 Rifle staged on Right Window

10 Pistols Holstered

Line: "Well sister, where do you stand on the sin of tobacco?"

Starting position: Standing at safe with hands on hat

Order: Shotgun, rifle, pistol

ATB:

Shotgun: engage knock downs until down

Rifle: from right window engage rifle targets in a 2-3-3-2 sweep.

Pistol: from opening engage pistol targets same as rifle.

Stage 8 – The Long Branch Saloon

10 Rifle staged on the right side of bar

10 Pistols Holstered

4+ Shotgun staged on the left side of the bar

Line: "I'm quite certain the Lord smokes a fine cigar"

Starting position: Hands at sides, position of choice

Order: Shooter's choice, rifle not last.

ATB:

Pistols: from right side of post engage targets in an Ambler sweep 2-3-5

Rifle: engage the rifle targets same as pistols

Shotgun: engage knock downs until down

Stage Notes: Right and left side of bar is defined by the seam in the center of the mat

If you can reach it you can shoot it

Stage 9 - The Ten Horn Livery

10 Rifle staged on the horse

10 Pistols staged or holstered

4+ Shotgun staged on shelf of choice

Line: "She is what she is because that's the way she wants to be"

Starting position: Shooters choice of horse or shelves with both hands on
bridle

Order: Shooter's choice, rifle not last.

ATB:

Pistol and rifle: engage each target 4 times each

Shotgun: engage 2 knock downs from both the right and left shelves

Stage Notes: Shotgun make up can be made up from anywhere safely.

Pistols may be staged or holstered and may be restaged or holstered
regardless of how they started.

Stage 10 – Boot Hill

10 Rifle staged on the left shelf

4+ Shotgun staged on the center table

10 Pistol Holstered

Line: “My mistake, make that four coffins”

Starting position: Hands on staged rifle

Order: Rifle, pistol, shotgun

ATB:

Rifle: Engage targets with 10 rounds placing at least one round on each target

Pistol: from right shelf repeat rifle instructions

Shotgun: from center opening engage knock downs until down.

Stage Notes: Pistols, one foot has to be at the shelf

Safety Rules

1. All SASS rules apply
2. Eye protection is required, hearing protection is strongly recommended for all competitors and spectators while competitors are shooting.
3. Lead bullets and shot size 4 or smaller only.
4. Firearm loading is allowed in designated areas only, generally the loading table before shooting stage. Cap and ball revolvers are not considered loaded until capped.
5. Muzzles of all firearms must be pointed in a safe direction at all times.
6. Any shooter unable to handle a firearm in a safe manner will be disqualified from the match.
7. It is the shooter's responsibility to move safely through each stage.
8. Function testing and practicing are not allowed once the competition is under way, unless under the direct supervision of a range officer. Work on malfunctioning firearms at the unloaded table only.
9. No alcohol consumption on the range until all shooting has been completed for the day. No shooting allowed after alcohol consumption.

Match Rules

1. All SASS rules apply.
2. In addition, this is a plant and poke shotgun range. One foot must be planted before loading shotgun.
3. No posse is allowed to skip ahead. Please allow the posse in front of you to clear the stage before entering.
4. Everything will be left on the stage: timers, iPads, and counting sticks.
5. Any disputed call which cannot be resolved by the posse marshal and their rule consiglieres will be brought to the rules committee for adjudication.
6. All animals must be on a leash. Neither service animals nor pets are permitted in the shooting bay. Animals must not disturb shooters or posse.
