21 DAY DEVOTIONAL

READ

DAY 14

Mark 14: 35-36 *And going a little farther, he threw himself on the ground and prayed that, if it were possible, the hour might pass from him. ³⁶ He said, "Abba, Father, for you all things are possible; remove this cup from me; yet, not what I want, but what you want." ³⁷ He came and found them sleeping; and he said to Peter, "Simon, are you asleep? Could you not keep awake one hour?" (NRSV)*

REFLECT

This Scripture is a very revealing one of Jesus our Christ. In this moment He is forced to deal with His divine nature and His human nature at the same time. His human nature wants to live and not die, but His divine nature is clear that whatever His Father wants is what needs to happen. This was His calling and the very act that would allow us to be free in Jesus. However, this freedom in Jesus was locked to His willingness to look beyond what He wanted and toward what He was called to do. God isn't asking us to physically die but God is asking or requiring of us to say, "Abba, Father" and end the statement with "but your will be done." As we continue in this season of fasting, we have to deny what we want outside of food and do what God has called and purposed us to do.
