



1 Myth #1: People just don't like change


Are you always happy about new software and innovations introduced at work?

2 Myth #2: They just can't handle change


Have you ever experienced any of the following when introduced to new software?

What's your main concern when it comes to new software/technology introduced at work?




- I wonder if it is here to replace me. AI revolution. Robots against humanity.
