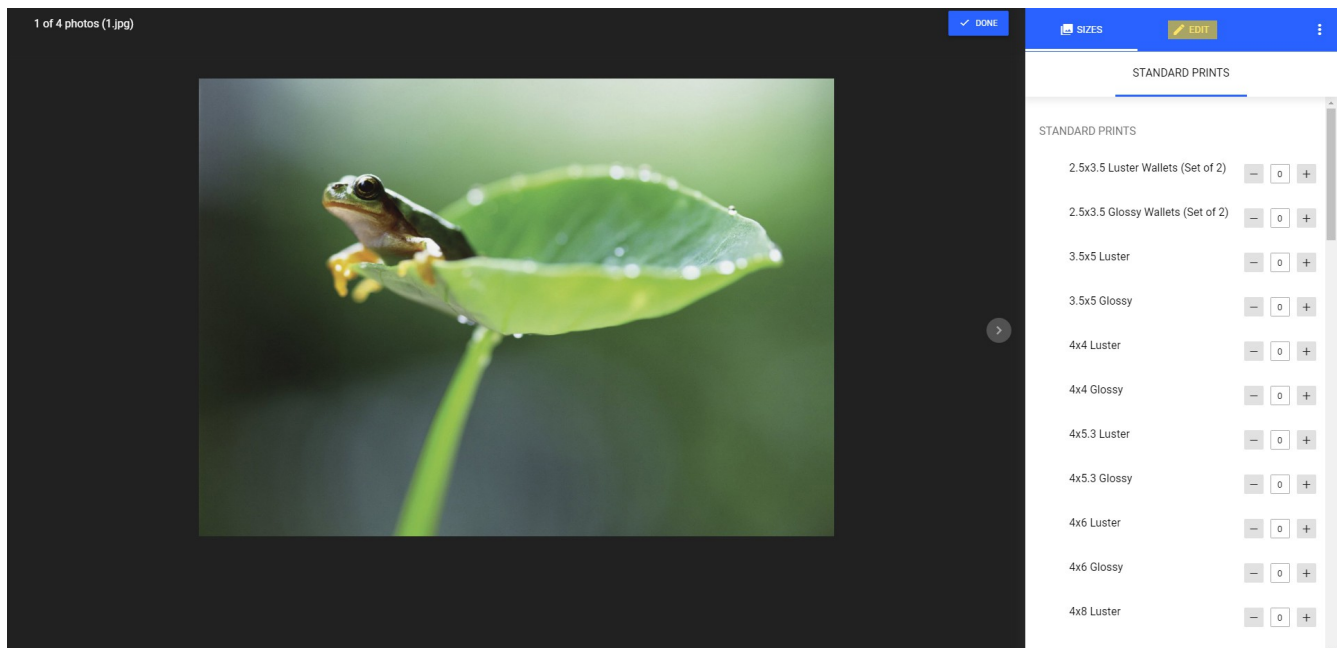


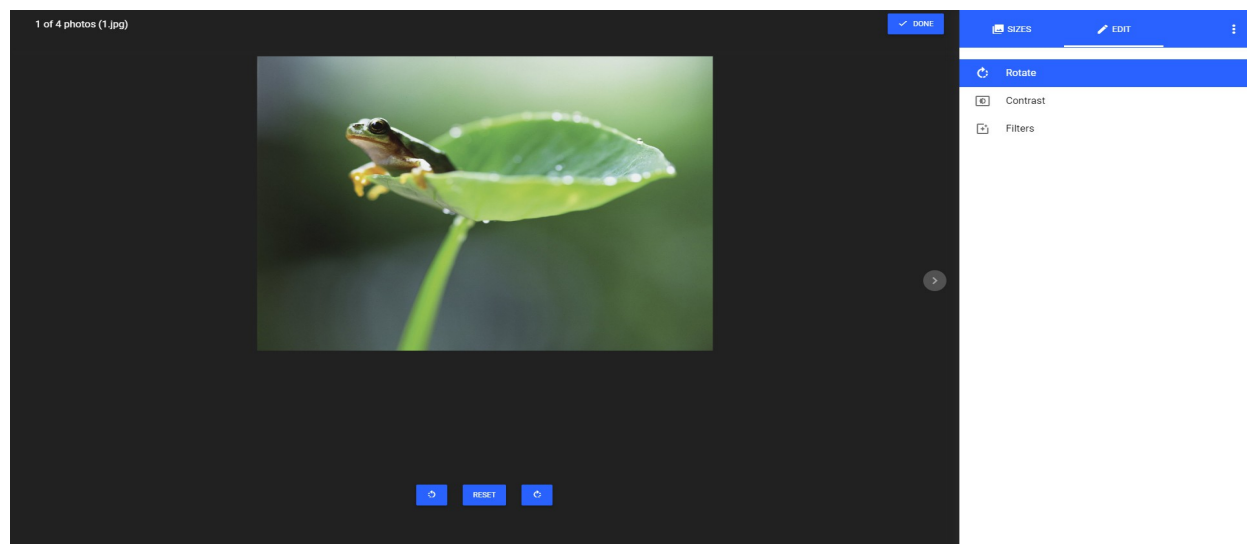
# How to Edit Photos in Dakis:

- Editing your photos can only be accessed when going through and ordering Standard Print sizes of your photos one by one.
- Editing options are limited.

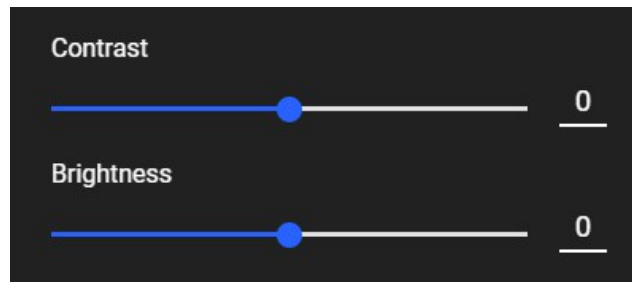
Once you have uploaded your photos (see our “How to Order Prints” guide for instructions on uploading photos), and they are visible on the easy view page, select the photo you would like to edit then click the “**EDIT**” tab in the top right corner of your screen:



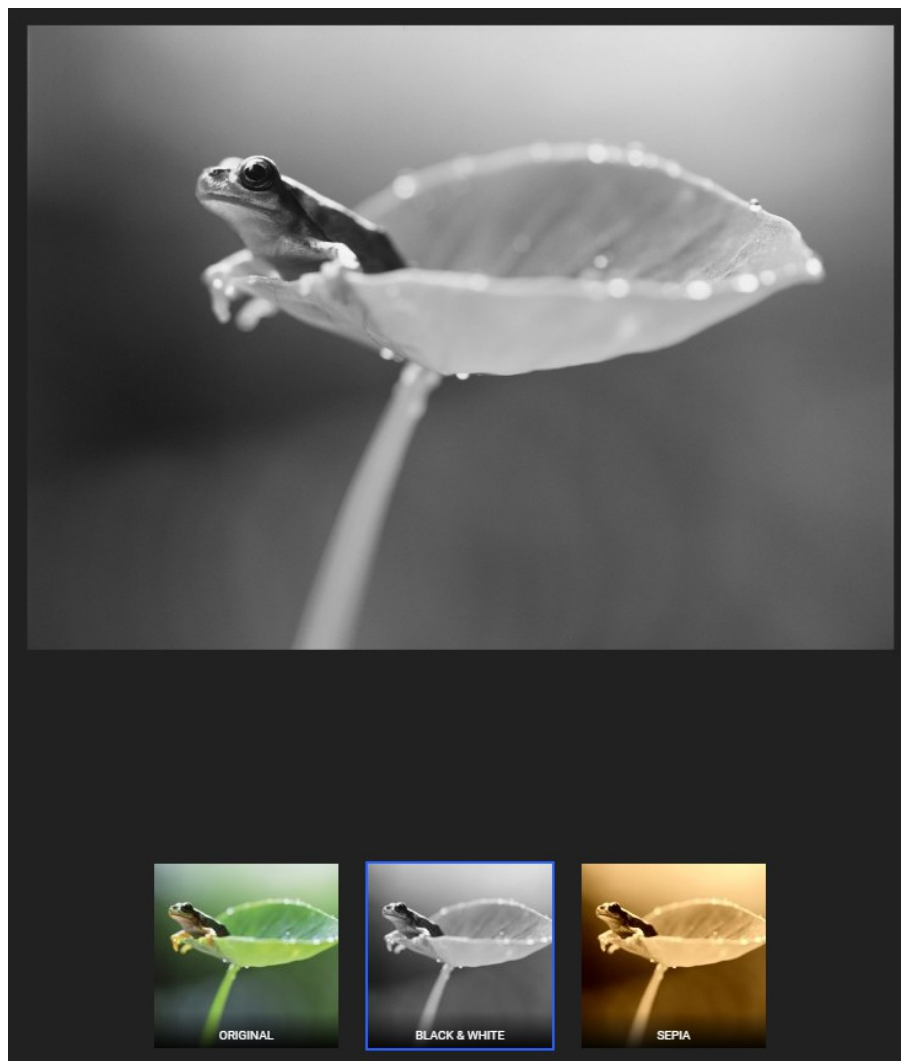
A drop down menu with the options, “Rotate”, “Contrast”, and “Filter” will pop up in the sidebar:



You can adjust the photo contrast and brightness of your photo by clicking on **“Contrast”**. Click and drag along the bars below your photo to achieve your desired contrast or brightness setting:

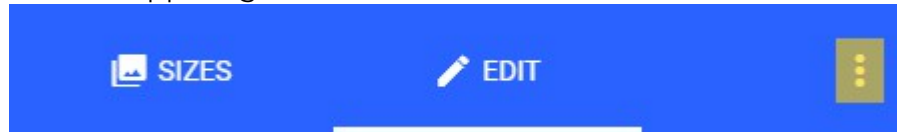


You can add a Black and White or Sepia filter to your image through the “Filters” option. Simply click on **“Filters”**, then select your desired filter from the icons below your photo:

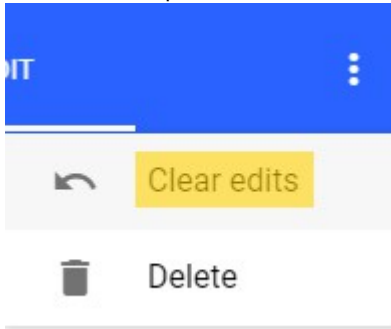


NOTE: If you want to remove the edits you have applied to your image, first click on the

three dots in the upper right corner:



Then, select "Clear Edits" from the drop down menu:



Your image will return to its original, un-edited, state.

NOTE: During the order review it may not display adjustments or cropping on prints ordered. However, the adjustments and cropping **will** show up on your prints!

When you are done with your edits and have chosen the print sizes for your photos, click **"DONE"**:
