

Ed Ullmann Proudly Announces "Pharmacy for the Public Good, Inc."

TANNERSVILLE -

There is a lot of excitement on the mountain top where folks come to relax, rejuvenate, and heal. Ed Ullmann of Wellness Rx, who on a daily basis blends traditional pharmacy with natural medicine, has put his decades of healthcare experience and wisdom back into his mortar and come out with a formula to rework pharmacy into a structure that finally makes sense.

His new remedy to heal our healthcare system is to transition to a nonprofit corporation under the banner of "Pharmacy for the Public Good."

On November 17, 2021, Ullmann's application was approved by the New York Department of State as a nonprofit corporation. Current efforts now move forward to apply for tax deductible 501(c)(3) status from the Internal Revenue Service.

Pharmacy for the Public Good has commenced a fundraising campaign, beginning with a grassroots GoFundMe, to achieve the buyout and conversion from the Limited Liability Company (LLC) to the nonprofit corporation, and to provide the capital for expansion of the model to other communities, to establish a mental health department, expand our public health activities, and expand our training programs for students wishing to enter the healthcare industry. Wellness Rx will continue to be the operational business name. Nothing will change with how they operate as a pharmacy and wellness center. Their mission, patient assistance fund, and charitable trust will continue to grow and help those in need. On December 3rd,

2021, The Windham Weekly's Mike Ryan wrote a story, "Wellness Rx Transitions to Non-Profit." In this article, Ryan addressed Ullmann's reasons to make this switch as this seems like a bold step. Following this announcement, Ullmann was beaming, "We are breaking new ground by creating a brand-new nonprofit model of community pharmacy and wellness centers. In fact, we will be the first community pharmacy in America to convert to a nonprofit structure. We have al-

ready made some very important connections and are looking at our next steps."

Ullmann continued, "Our goal is to ensure that we remain sustainable and permanent for each community we serve, including our main hub in Tannersville, and our first expansion coming soon to Phoenicia, NY. Just like a community supports its library, we want our community to see Wellness Rx in the same way and with the same passion. I feel that going nonprofit is our best strategy to achieve this goal and also the best strategy to provide new job opportunities in each community that we expand to. This is an exciting time for us and the corporation we are building. It's time that community leaders step up their efforts to deal with today's issues, especially public health, mental health, and training. The



biggest reason to do this is for tomorrow's kids, and all of the generations to come. They deserve to have local quality healthcare options available to them within their own communities. Healthcare is a human right!"

Ullmann has developed over 30 start-up companies, and for 16 years served as an HMO founder and CEO at WellCare. He has also been a Pharmacy District Manager, a County Mental Health Director, County Legislator, and was owner/operator of the world-renowned Warm Mineral

Springs in Florida. He was named "1994 HealthCare Entrepreneur of the Year in Southern New England" by Inc. Magazine and received the "Community Health Improvement Partnership (CHIP) Visionary Award" from Sarasota County, Florida in 2007. In October of 2020, Ullmann was honored by Pharmacy Times, a national pharmaceutical publication, in their "Faces of Pharmacy" award.
