

Welcome to the Adirondack Pet Lodge! This is our Boarding and Daycare Contract.

Our Pet care Specialists pay very close attention to all of the dogs and cats in our care. The vast majority of the time, our daycare classes run smoothly and the dogs behave and have fun. However, some dogs are unpredictable and may decide to play roughly. We are not responsible for any injuries that may occur in our daycare classes, we will seek medical treatment for your dog if necessary, and you will be responsible for any of those expenses.

Hours vary for half and full days and you have to schedule a new dog introduction. Please ask front for details. Must have Bordetella, distemper and rabies vaccine (cats only distemper and rabies) to enter our building, we have the right to decline your stay if not up to date.

If a dog is misbehaving in daycare (overly aggressive or overly frightened) we reserve the right to remove them from the daycare class at any time, for their health and safety and that of their classmates.

We will do everything in our power to get your toys, blankets, beds or treats back to you but we are not responsible for the loss of any that accompany your pet's stay with us. We have the right to move boarding pets to a different kennel if deemed necessary; you will be charged for the change and will be contacted if needed to move.

Regardless of your pickup time on Sunday, there is a full day's charge. If you pick up before noon on Monday (or any other day, Mon - Sat), there is no boarding charge for that day.

Please call us and let us know that your pet will be picked up late staying longer so we can accommodate everyone!

Please tell us about any and all medical concerns about your pet. It is agreed that you give us your consent to act on your behalf by obtaining veterinary care at your expense, should the Adirondack Pet Lodge deem it necessary. We do not allow pets with recent surgeries in daycare. Pets must have completed their recovery time and get a vet and manager approval in order to return to daycare or board. If your pet(s) becomes ill the Adirondack Pet Lodge will not be held responsible. You have read the schedule of fees and agree to pay all charges at checkout. You authorize the Adirondack Pet Lodge to charge your credit card account for any outstanding invoices. You release the Adirondack Pet Lodge and its agents and employees from any liability or claim due to injury or death of your pet. You understand that under no circumstances will the Adirondack Pet Lodge be liable for damages. If a daycare dog acts out of character or unpredictably and your dog is injured you agree not to hold Adirondack Pet Lodge, its agents or staff liable in any way for these unforeseen acts. In the event of a medical situation, the manager on duty will notify you immediately and depending on the situation, call your veterinarian. If we cannot reach you or your vet, we will call the Plattsburgh Animal Hospital to address the needs of your pet. You will be responsible for any expenses that are incurred.

It is understood by the Adirondack Pet Lodge and Owner that all provisions of this Contract shall be binding upon both parties thereunto for this visit and for all subsequent visits.
