RED

- Bright ruby in color with vibrant aromas of redcurrant, blackberry and candied violets
- A well balanced, juicy, dry red wine, with floral red berry flavors makes it perfect for summer.
- Located in Northeast Italy, The Brigaldara Winery is a family-run operation in the heart of the Valpolicella region along the Adriatic Sea in Veneto Italy.

WHITE

BORGO SAVAIAN, "ARANSAT," PINOT GRIGIO (orange wine)

- Amber-colored, copper tones with notes of dried rose and aromatic herbs
- Ripe apricot, peach and meyer lemon, with honey rounded out with a little spice for a rich, wonderful texture
- A fun and funky naturally produced wine, "Aransat" is slang for *orange* in the Friulian region of Northeast Italy.

ROSÉ

PRISMA ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR - ACONCAGUA

- Bright red fruit notes bursting with flavors of fresh strawberry and raspberry, with an underlying hint of melon.
- A refreshing alternative to the classic styles of rosé from California and Provence, Prisma wines are certified sustainably farmed and hand-harvested in Chile's Casablanca Valley.
- Located at 1,000 feet altitude, the coastal microclimate benefits from fog, daily shifts in temperature and granitic soils that produce a fresh, lively wine.
