



We know that in these uncertain times, safety is of the utmost importance. Our goal is to provide a safe space for all who enter Fulton Alley while maintaining a hospitable and fun experience. With that in mind, we have developed a playbook outlining the steps of safety we're committed to as we re-open our doors in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic.

- 1. ENHANCED SAFETY PRACTICES** implemented not only for our guests, but also staff and vendors of Fulton Alley.
- 2. TEMPERATURE CHECK** required of staff and vendors prior to entering the building.
- 3. "AGENTS OF CLEAN"** who will be present for every service, dedicated to continuously sanitizing all touch points including sanitizing bowling balls after individual use.
- 4. HAND-WASHING AND HAND SANITIZING OPPORTUNITIES** Hand washing/sanitizing stations have been added throughout Fulton Alley above what is required.
- 5. NEW REQUIRED PROCEDURES FOR ALL EMPLOYEES** including increased hand-washing procedures, the use of approved face masks provided by Brechtel Hospitality, and wearing and changing gloves regularly.
- 6. TOUCHLESS IMPROVEMENTS** including touchless menus.
- 7. PRIVATE LANE RESERVATIONS AND SEATING** and a socially distanced environment implemented by spacing tables and chairs over 6ft apart.
- 8. PROVIDING A SAFE SPACE** for employees to share if they feel unwell or begin exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19. This includes paid leave under the Families First Coronavirus Response Act.

Due to the order by the Governor of Louisiana - Masks are mandated to be worn in public. The use of face covering will be required to enter/exit Fulton Alley. Fulton Alley will provide you with a face mask should you need one.
