We can transfer movie film in 8mm, Super 8 and 16mm format to DVD. A DVD can hold up to 1600ft in 8mm and Super 8 format and 3200ft in 16mm format. Pricing starts over once those limits are reached. Pricing is below. We only convert home footage to DVD. Any copyright protected material will not be converted to DVD. PLEASE NOTE: This is a service that we provide, however, we send all movie reels to YESVIDEO Inc. to be converted to DVD. Movie Film to DVD - Prices

First 250 Feet: \$54.99 Every foot after that: \$0.20 per foot

1600ft limit* for 8mm, Super 8
3200ft limit* for 16mm

*Once you have reached the limit pricing will start over.
Ex. You have 2000 feet of 8mm. 1600 feet of that will go on one 1 DVD and charged at \$54.99 (first 250ft) and \$0.20 per foot after. The remaining 400ft will go on a second DVD and charged at \$54.99 (first 250ft) and \$0.20 per foot after.

Movie Film Reel Footage Calculator


Use this calculator below for assistance if unsure how much footage you have.

How to Use: Place movie reel on top of the lines below. Line up the edge of the reel to the edge of the small vertical line on the left side. The other edge of your reel will line up with either the 3", 5", or 7" vertical line on the right side. Whichever one it lines up with will tell you how long the film is on that reel. **NOTE:** Some movie reels will have indicator marks on them to inform you the length of footage that is on the reel and you can use that to determine how much film is on the reel. If a reel does show you indicator marks but reel is partially filled then round up to the nearest 100 of the indicator marks.

Ex. Reel is estimated at 230ft. Please round up to 300ft.

Your price will be prorated to the actual footage length you have when it is properly measured by our technicians.

Below is what each movie film will look like and its approximate size.



3" reel - 50 feet

5" reel - 200 feet

7" reel - 400 feet

How to tell if your reels have audio

8mm: Look for a yellow or rust colored strip on the very edge of the film next to the sprocket holes

Super 8: Look for a yellow or rust colored strip on the very edge opposite side of the sprocket holes and then a very thin strip on the edge next to the sprocket holes.

16mm: If your film has sprocket holes on one side of the film then it has sound. There will be a yellow or rust colored strip on the opposite side of the sprocket holes. If your film has sprocket holes on both sides of the film then it does not have sound.

If you do not see the yellow or rust colored strips as mentioned above then your film is silent.

Combining multiple reels to one DVD requires the movie film to be spliced together. Your reels will be sent back to you on one big reel. Total service time for your order will be 4-8 weeks.
