- A share of your estate (Residuary Legacy): Once you've worked out what you're leaving to family and friends, you can donate a share, or all of what's left.
- A specific sum of money (Pecuniary Legacy): If you want to leave a lump sum to the African Prisons Project, you can specify this amount in your will.
- A specific item: Jewellery, a first edition book, or any item that you think will be of some value to our work when its sold.
