

COVID-19 - What to expect at your next dental appointment

- Please limit the number of people accompanying you to your appointment. Individuals other than caregivers or responsible parties will be asked to remain outside the practice during your appointment.
- Please wear a mask or some form of cloth covering your nose and mouth.
- **Upon Arrival:**
 - Please remain in your vehicle or the building lobby and call our office when you are here for your appointment, we will instruct you when to come in.
- Patient Screening:
 - Appropriate screening and consent forms will be emailed to you within 48hrs of your appointment. Please contact us ASAP at (303)279-6929 if you require assistance completing these forms.
 - Your temperature will be taken prior to entering the practice.
 - We kindly ask that you use the provided hand sanitizer at our screening station.
 - Chairs in our waiting room will be positioned 6ft apart from one another.
- Treatment rooms:
 - In addition to complying with the standard precautions that have kept our patients and staff safe for many years, we will be adhering to the ongoing advice of the CDC, American Dental Association, Colorado Dental Association, Colorado Department of Public Health and OSHA regarding COVID-19
- Please note that we will be limiting social distance, including handshaking, as a means of decreasing possible transmission of Coronavirus (COVID-19)
- The team at Golden Peak Dental are screened daily. In the case of a team member testing positive for COVID-19 then patients will be notified ASAP
- We kindly request if you are diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days following your dental appointment that you inform our office.
