


### Wee **Daniel**



Our Residents enjoyed a lovely singsong to Daniel O'Donnell - we have some very big fans in the house.


Although we couldn't have the man himself here - we had the next best thing – a life sized version - which gave a lot of our Residents a fright at first as they thought it was the real Daniel.

## **Jigsaw** Fun




Nothing like a good jigsaw puzzle to pass a cold November afternoon -and we love a good jigsaw in Terenure Nursing Home.

# Hamper





## Afternoon of **Pampering**






