Nothing like a good jigsaw puzzle to pass a cold November afternoon -and we love a good jigsaw in Terenure Nursing Home.





Birthday Celebrations

We are all hoping for sweet dreams in Terenure Nursing Home - we made this bright and colourful Dream catcher to cheer up the place on a dull November day.



