understand why I couldn't come in.


'She has dementia and some days she'd recognise me but others she

country to get Covid-19. Jackie said: "She's 82 and she also has COPD so we were prepared for the worst. But she got through it.
















Care Pack Gifts








Childrens **Christmas Choir**
