## Spring Time



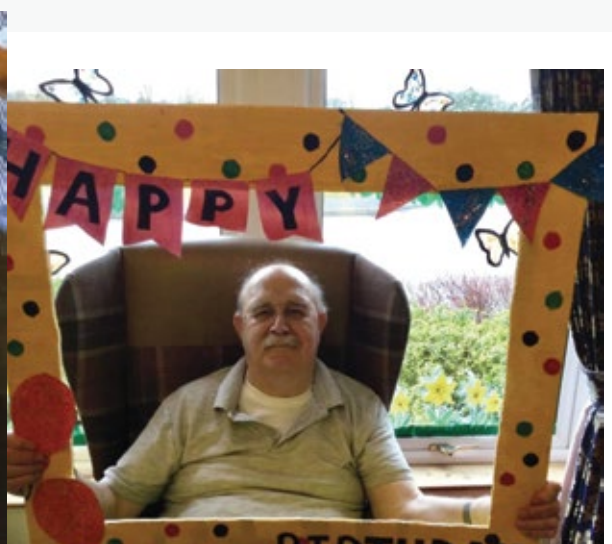
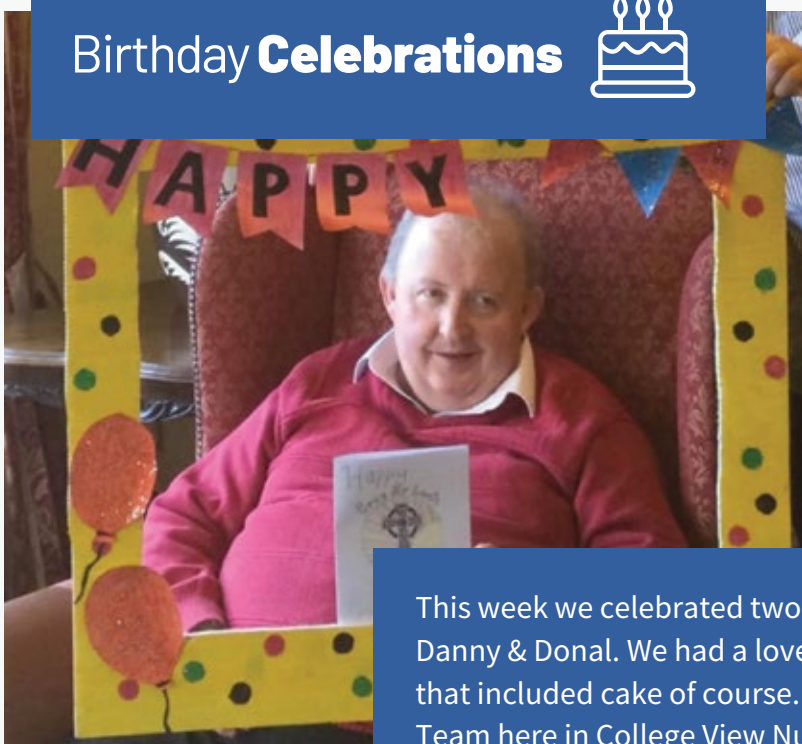
