St Patrick's Arts & Crafts



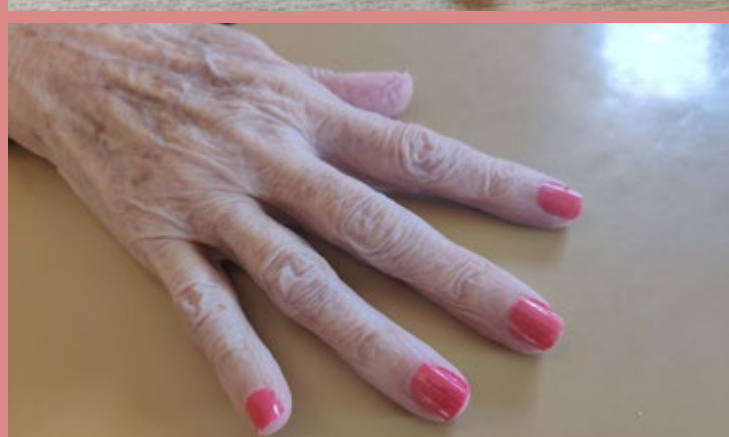
Residents enjoyed making some shamrocks in our art session in Terenure Nursing Home, we hung them up in our sitting room for decorations in the run up to St Patrick's day.

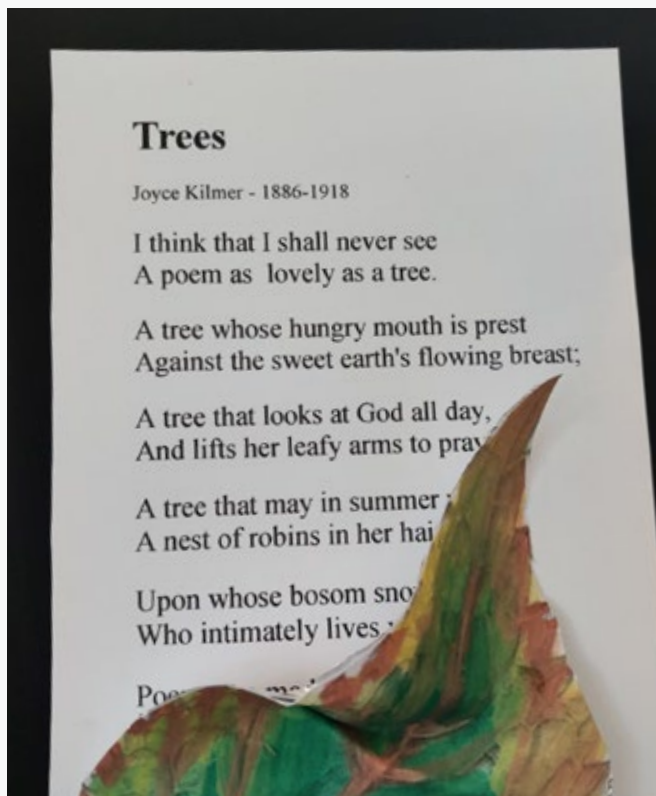
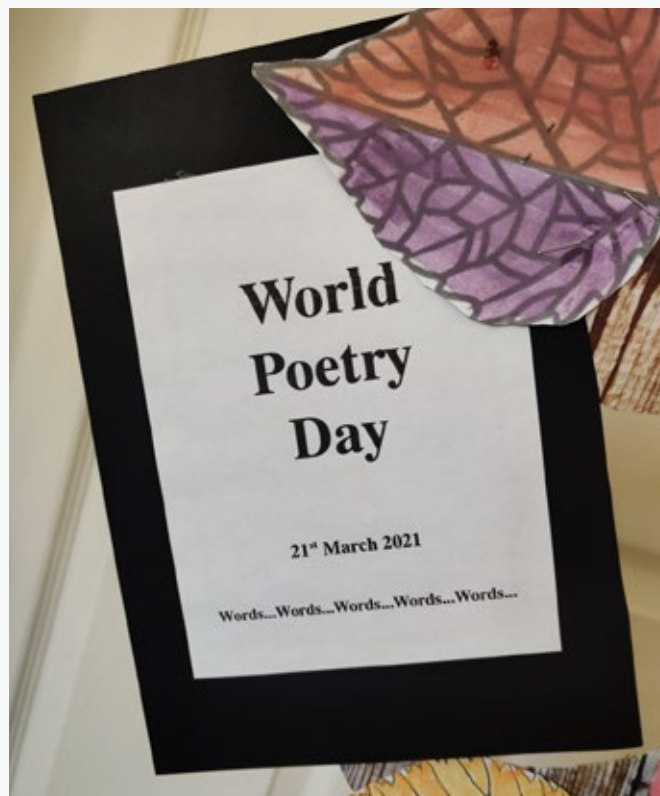


St Joseph's Church
