Mikey's Back!!



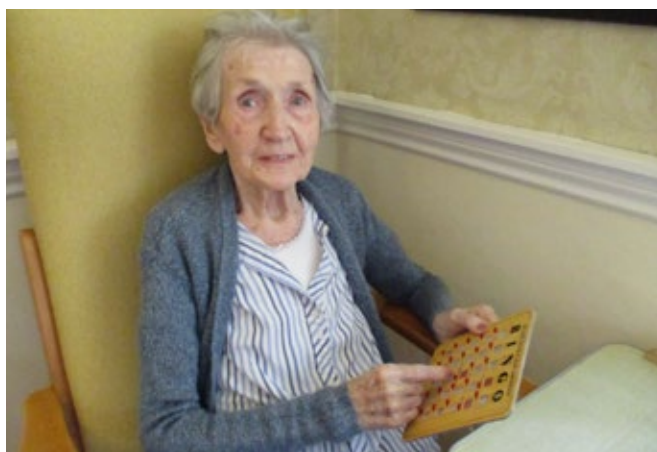

Easter Sunday



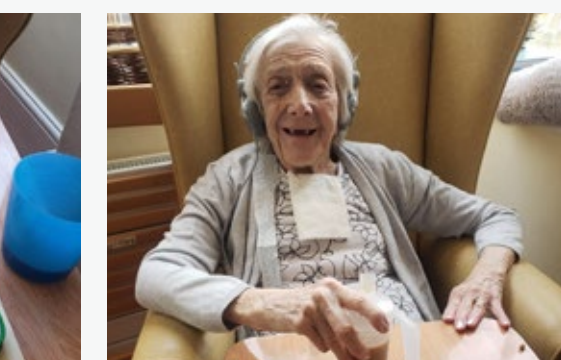
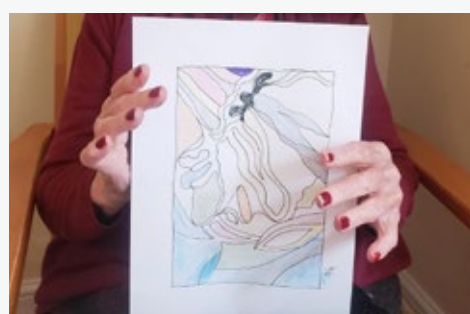
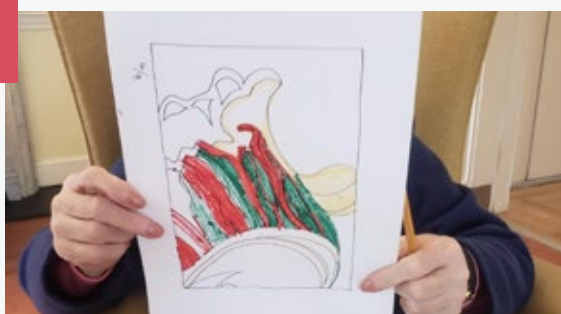

An Afternoon of Gardening



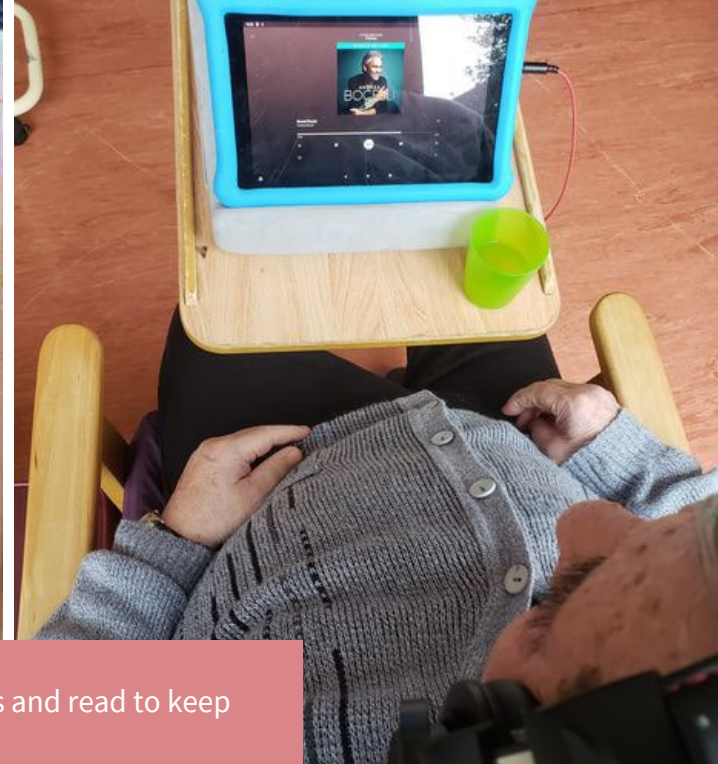
As the weather was just fabulous our Residents headed to the garden to do a bit of gardening and planting.
