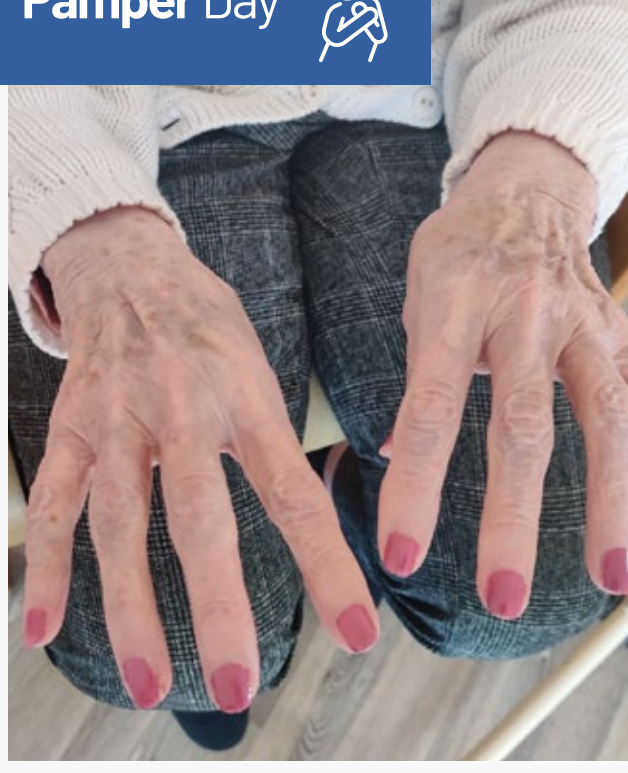

Rose's 107th Birthday!!!



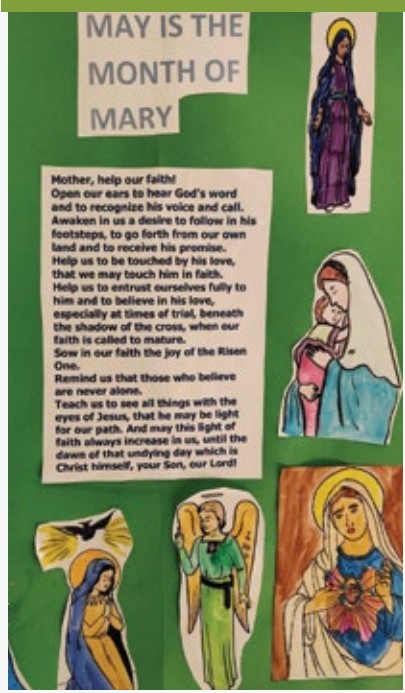

Pamper Day



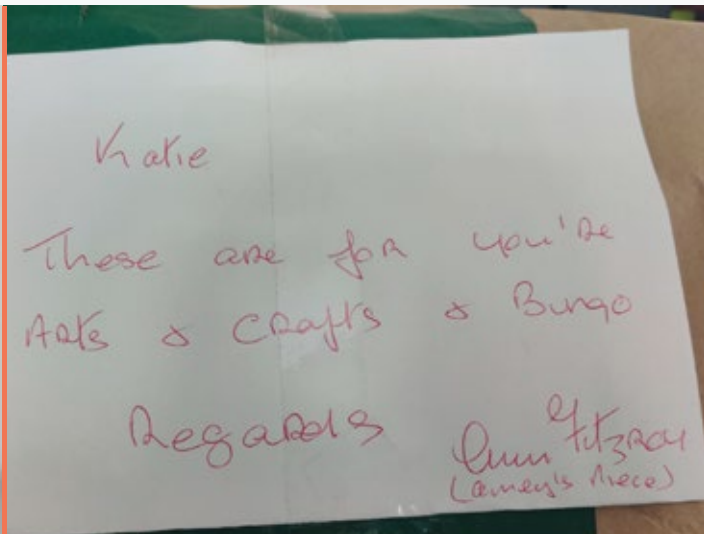

Arts & Crafts



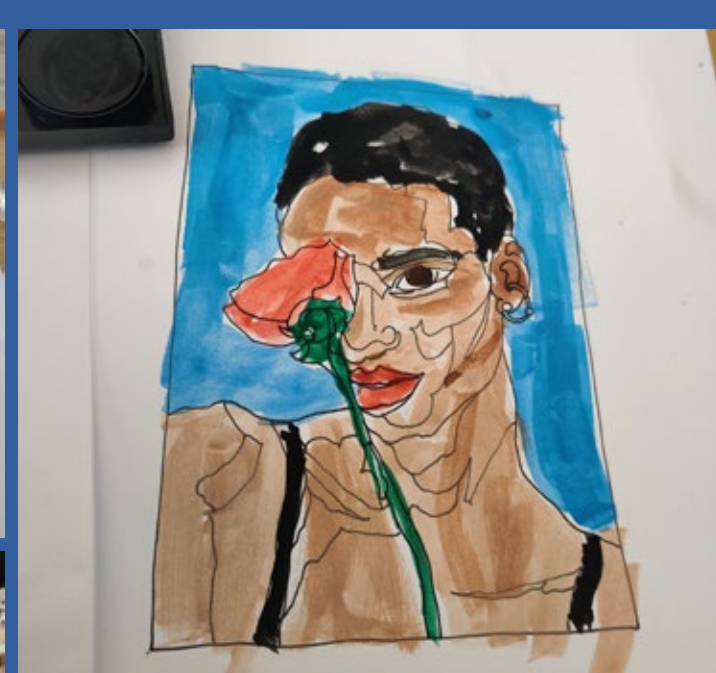
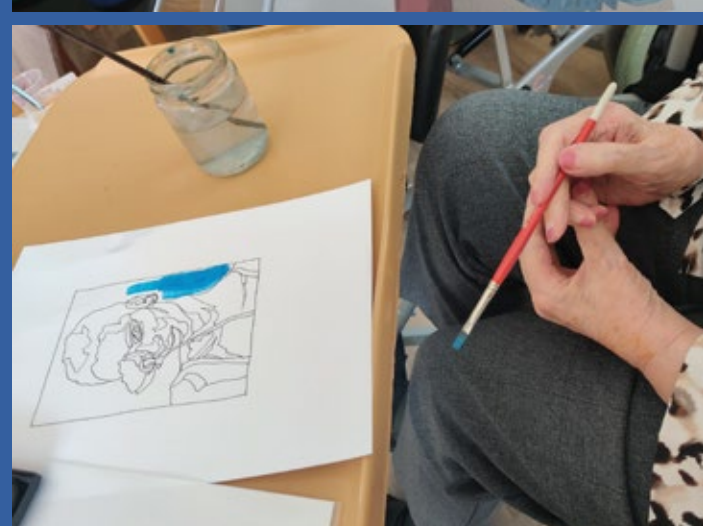
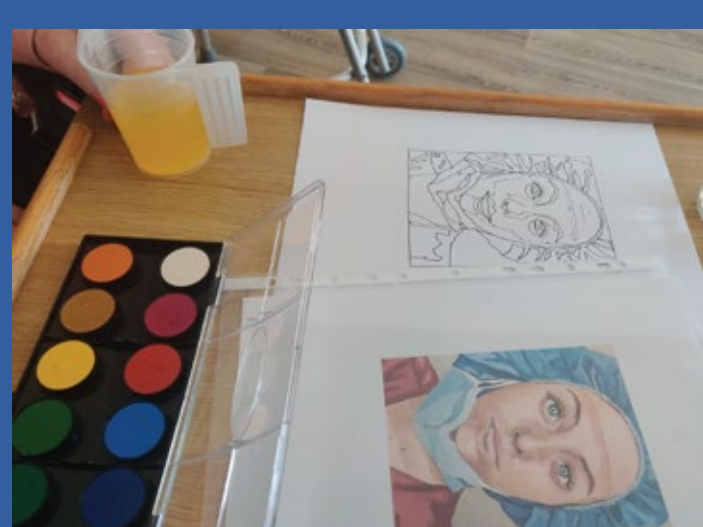

The Bealtaine Festival



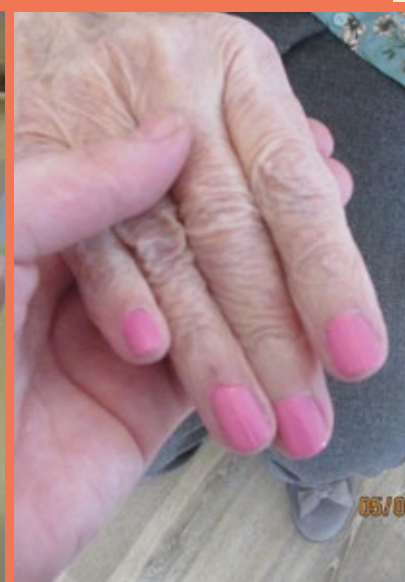

International Tea Day



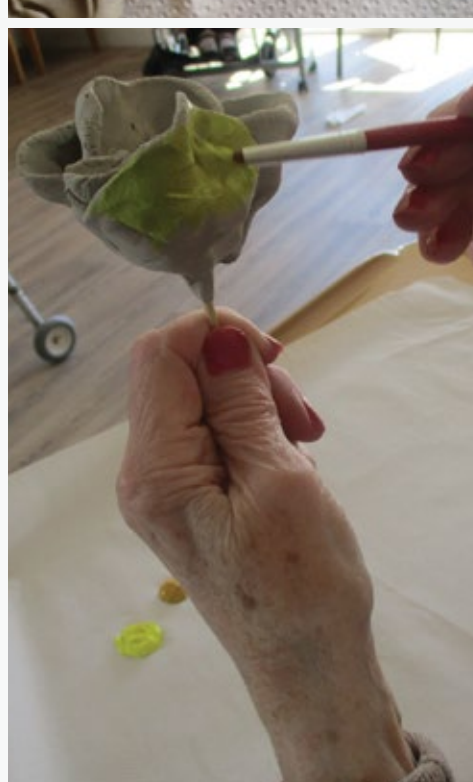
