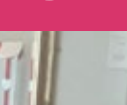
## Morning Tea-party

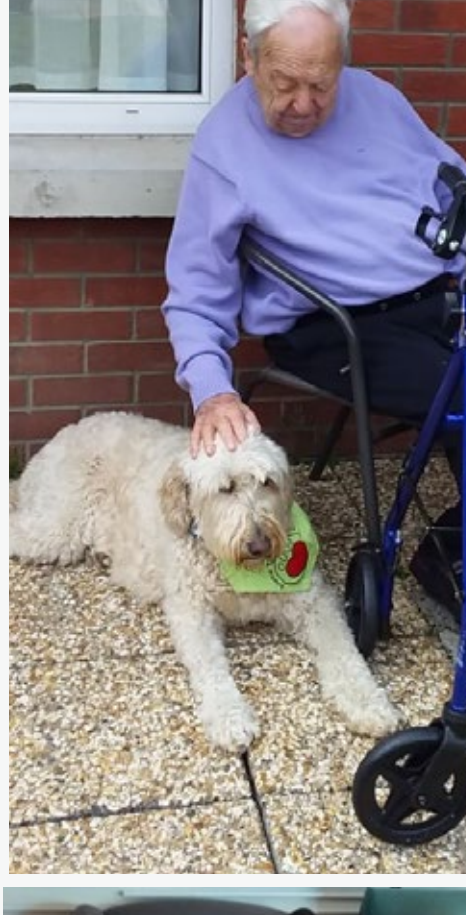


## Artistic Creations



In Tara Winthrop Private Clinic we created a fabulous mosaic in our Arts & Crafts class. The production line was in full swing as we painted our mosaic tiles.

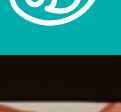
## A Visit from Bailey

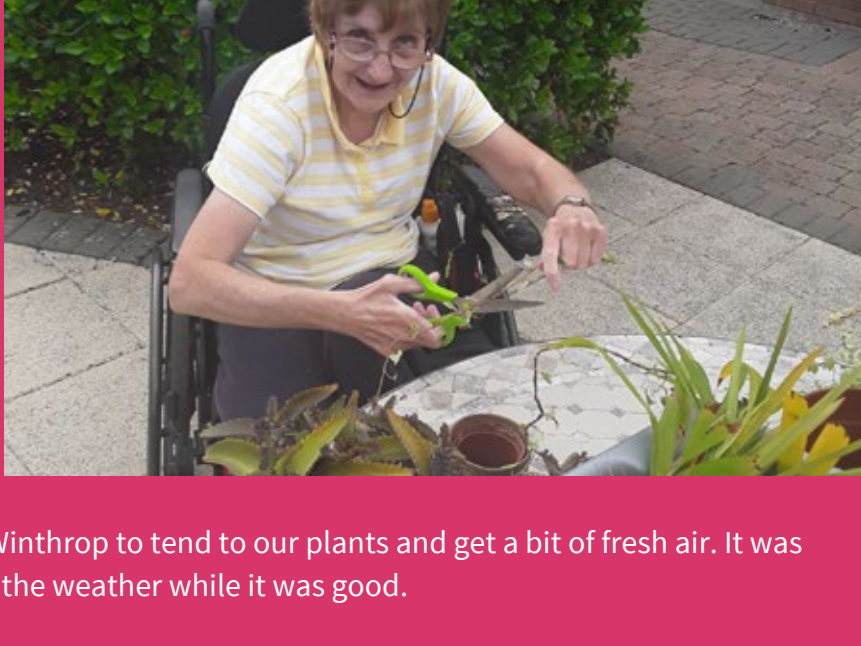
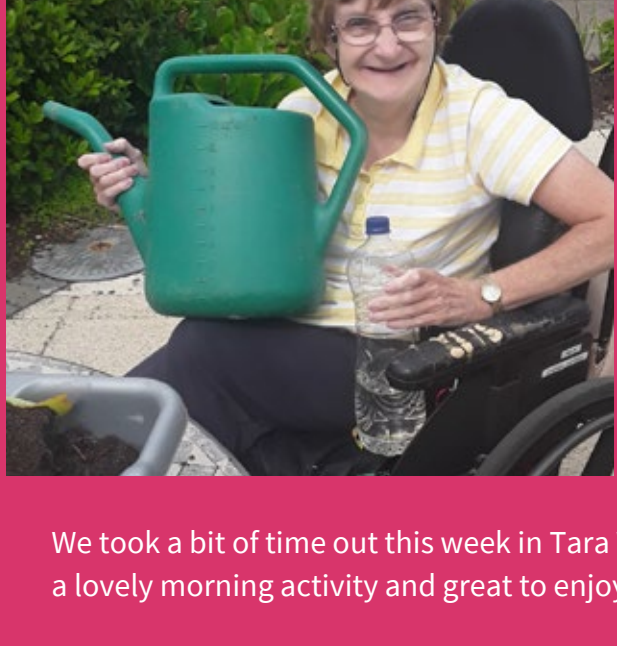
## Bloomsday



In Tara Winthrop we celebrated Bloomsday with an Arts and Crafts session in honour of Leopold Bloom and James Joyce.

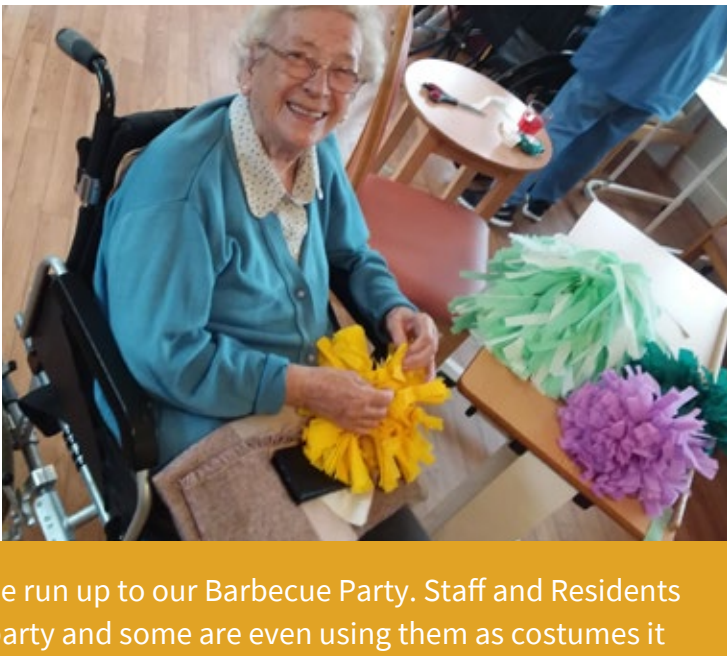
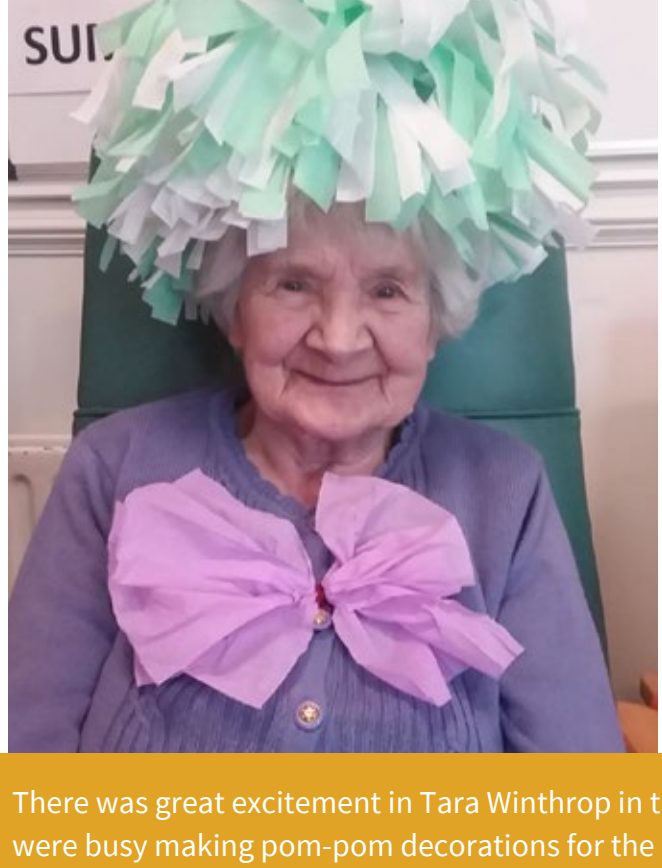
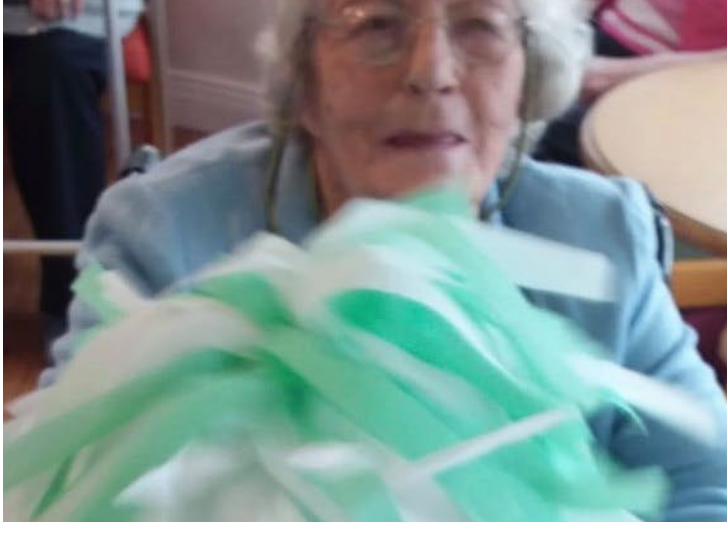


## Green Fingers



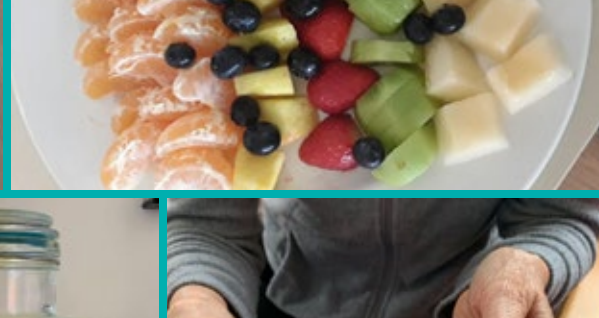
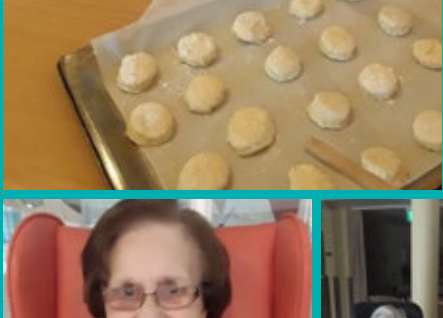

## Party Preparations



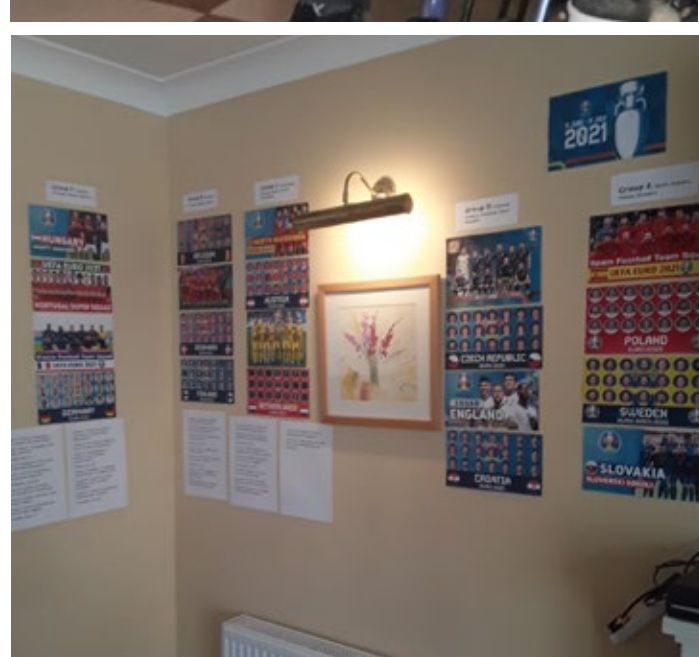
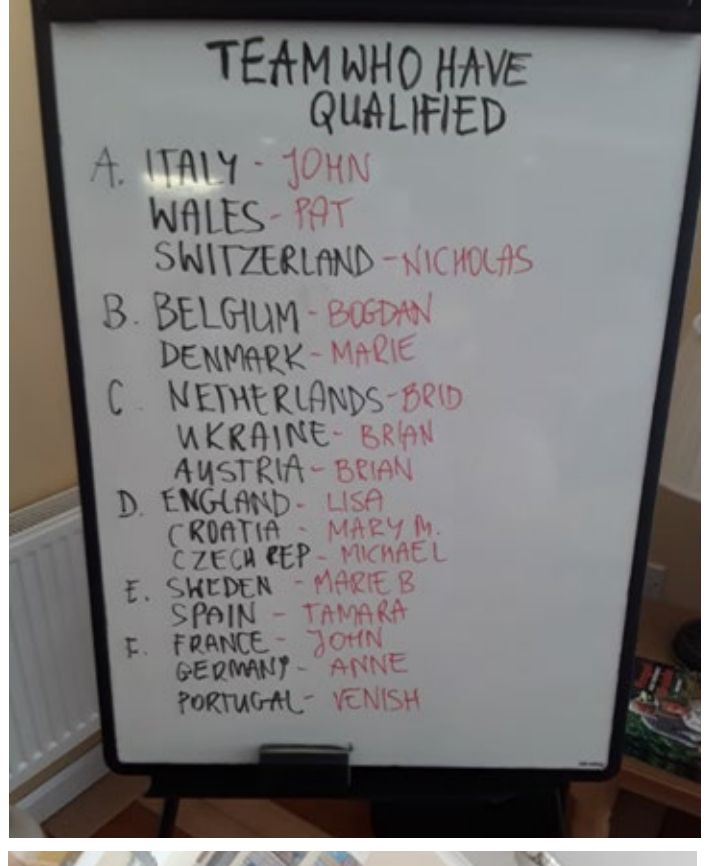

## Nutrition & Hydration Week



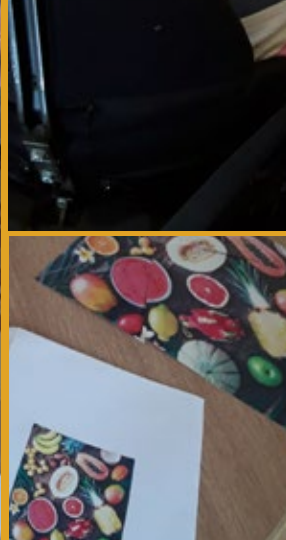
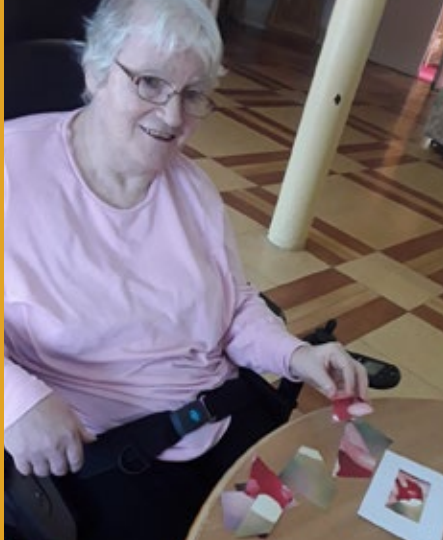
