A Wonderful **Surprise**



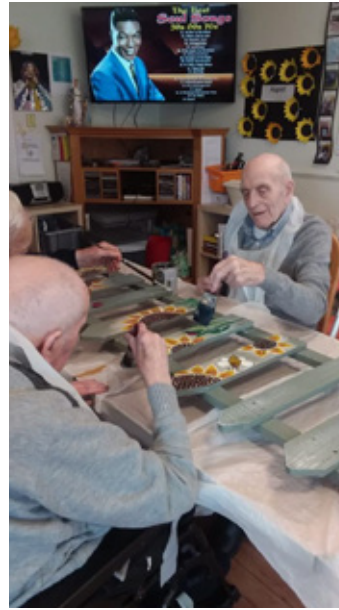

Our **Mens&Womens** Shed



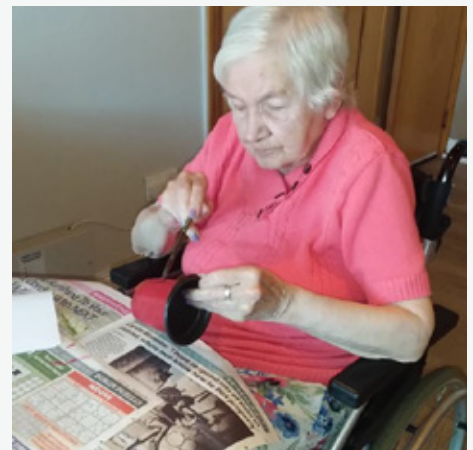

Summer **Party** 🎉



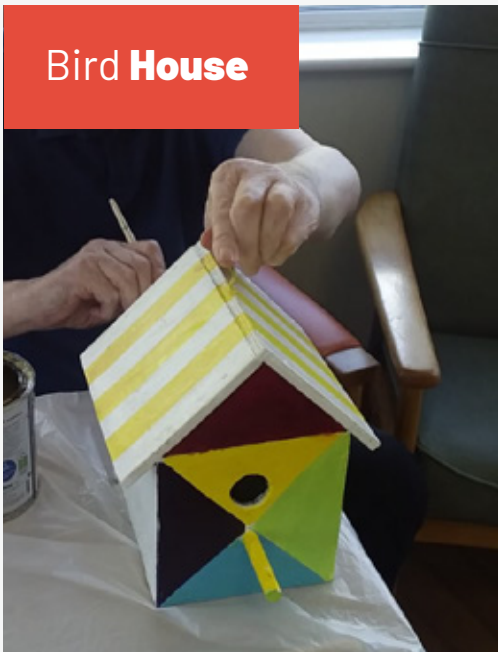

Craft Project



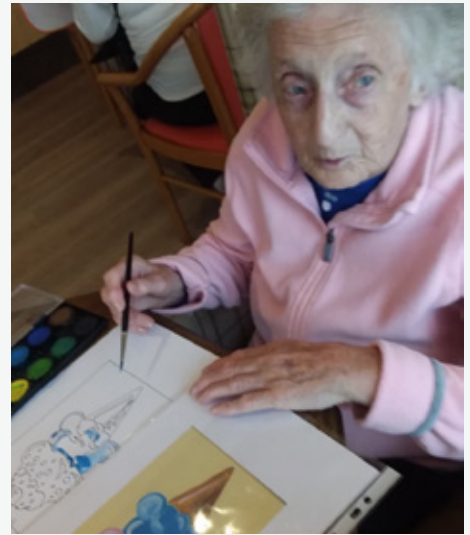
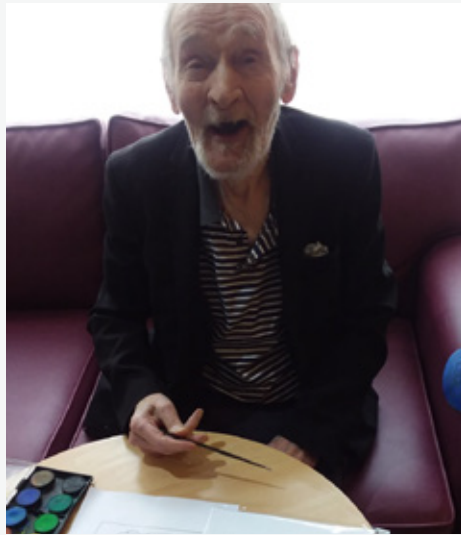
