Arts Programme



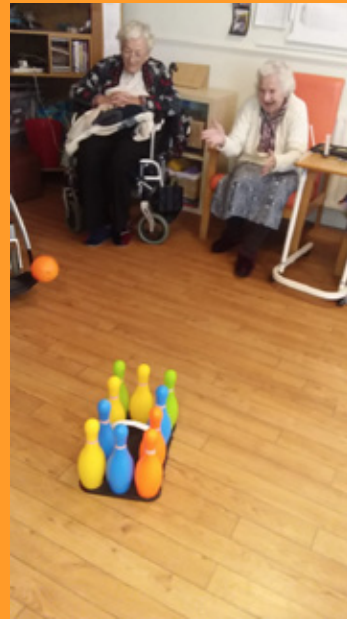

Lego Master



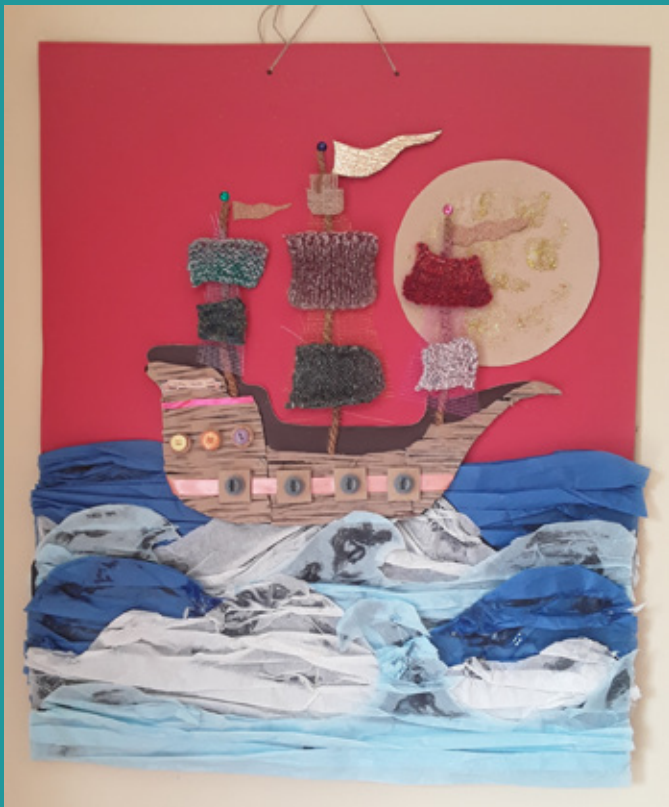

3D Ship

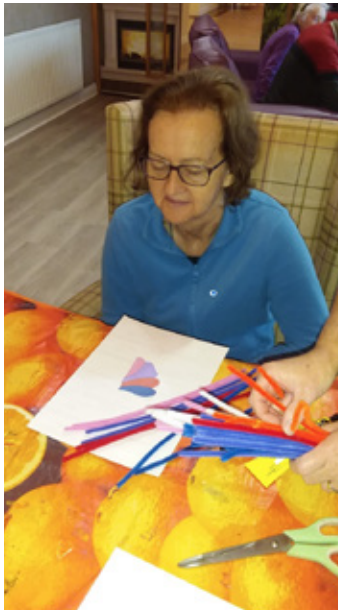


This week Tracey our Art teacher came to Tara Winthrop and we created this amazing 3D ship in our class. Our Residents just love working together on projects like this.

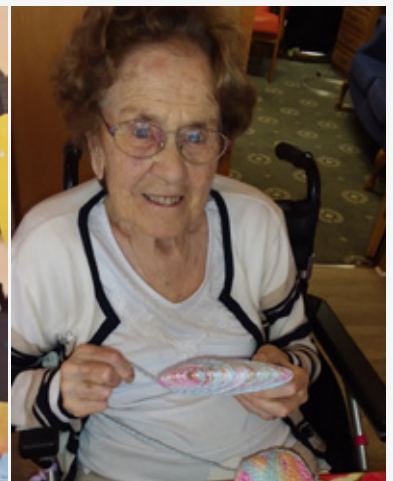
Our residents here in Tara Winthrop were busy creating these beautiful doves in this weeks Art Workshop with Treacy.
