

A Fond Farewell



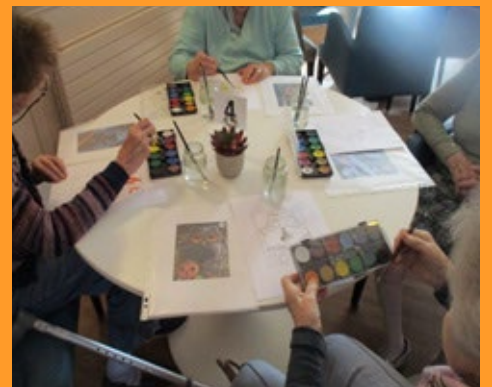
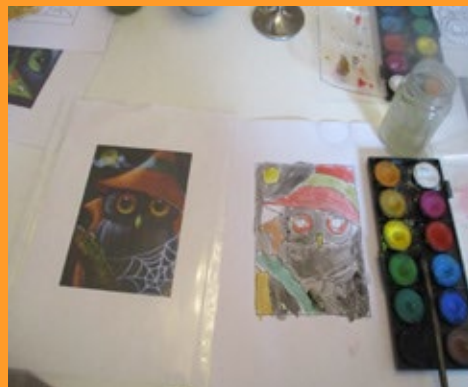

Halloween Arts & Crafts



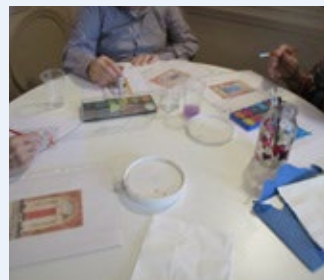

Pumpkin Carving



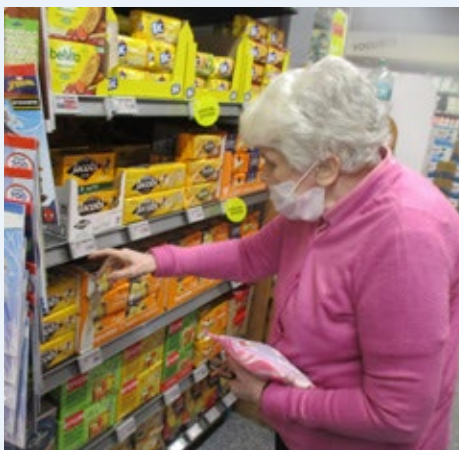
Our Residents were getting into Halloween mode here in St. Glady's Nursing Home this week by carving pumpkins while sharing ghost stories - all happy ones of course!!
