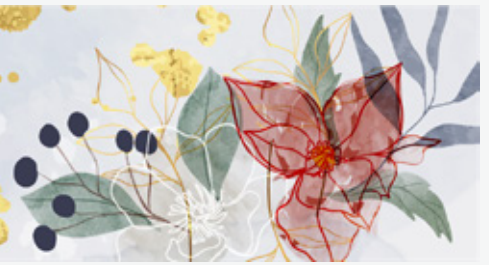

Here's to **2022!!**



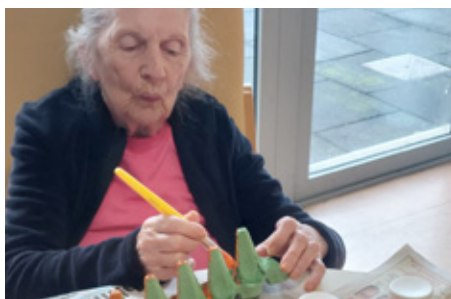
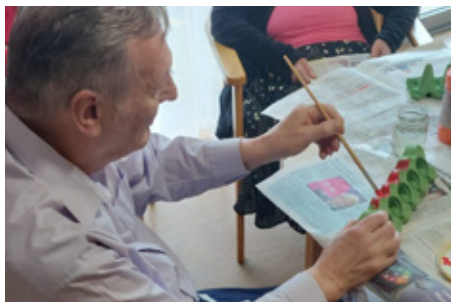
