

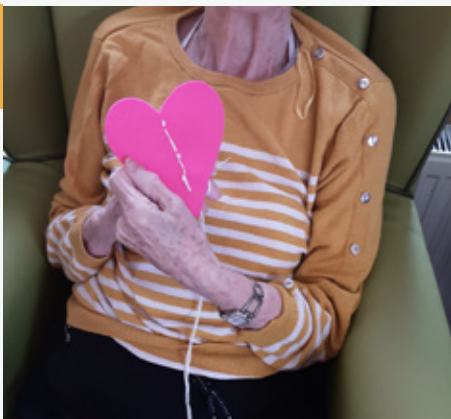


## Ida's Birthday Celebrations

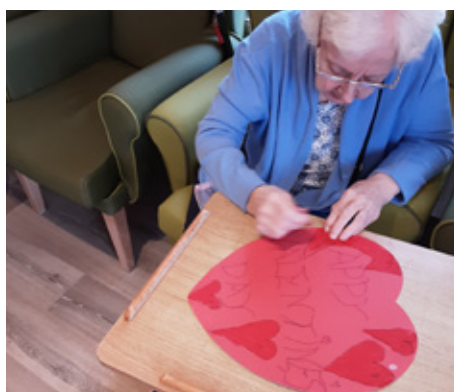
## About **Me**

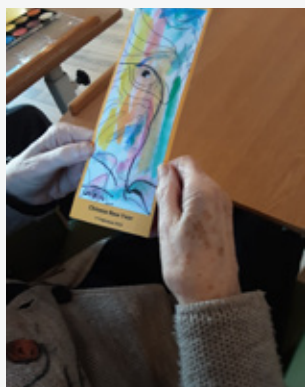
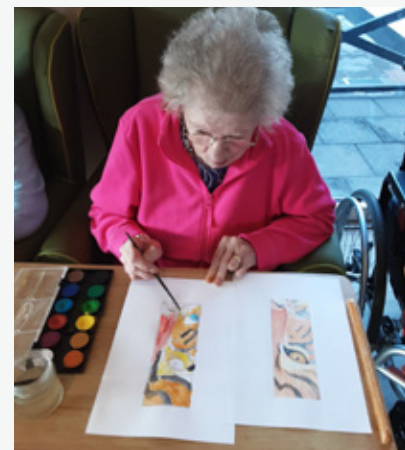
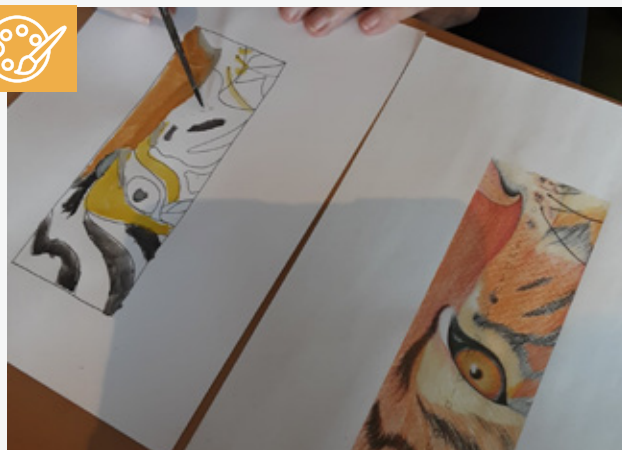
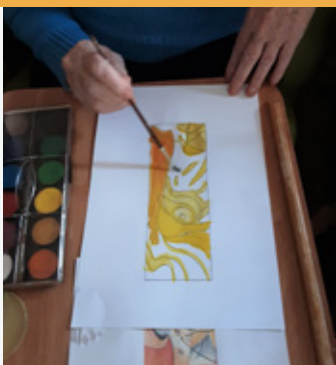


## Valentine's Arts & Crafts
