

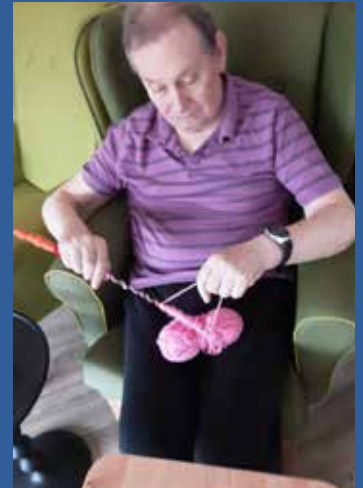
STORIES FROM May & June
