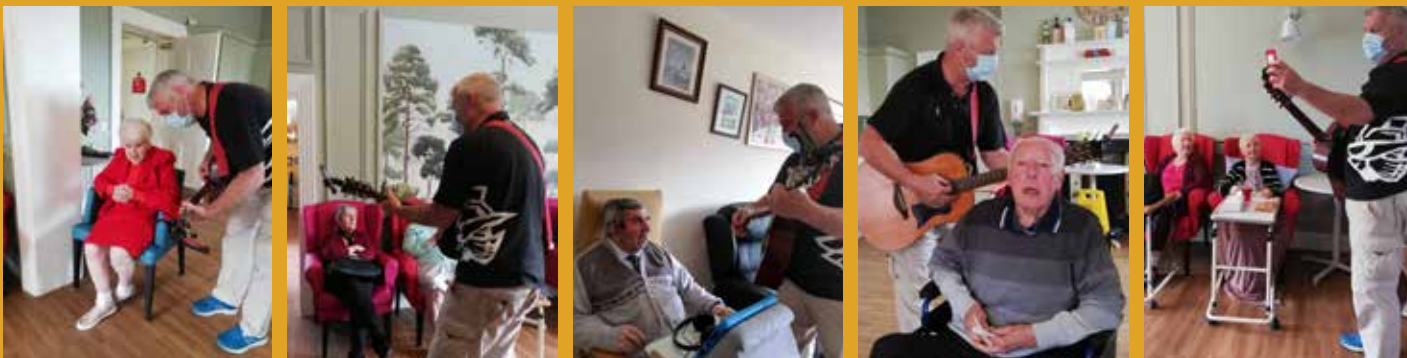


Father's Day Celebrations

In Memory of Carmel



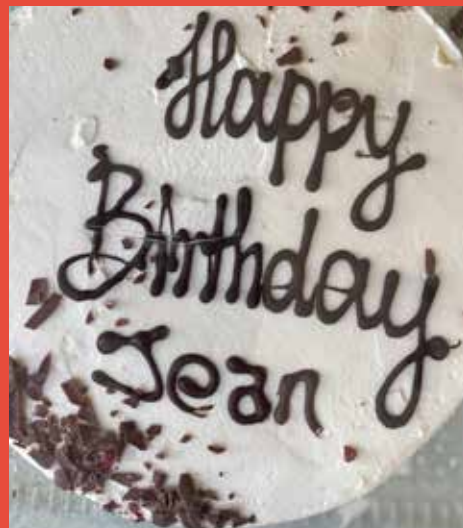

Relaxing **Weekends**



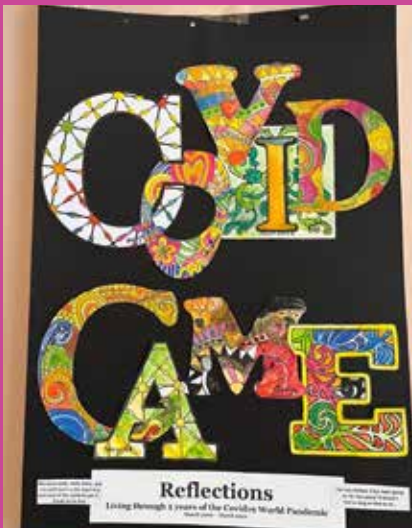
