Christmas Song Session



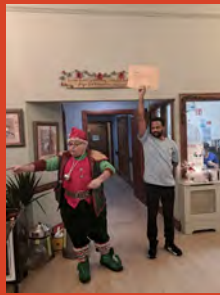
Our College View Staff had a ball entertaining our Residents with a Christmas song session - it was great fun and our Residents really enjoyed the performances.
