

NORTH COAST THROWDOWN CORNHOLE TOURNAMENT

Teams play a Blind Draw Round Robin with 8 pools. The top three teams from each Round Robin Pool will be placed in a Blind Draw Single Elimination Championship Tournament to determine the overall winner!

BLIND DRAW ROUND ROBIN:

8 Pools with 6 teams in each pool - 48 teams total

Each team plays every other team in their pool to determine the top three teams in each pool. Each match will be played to 21 points or 20 minutes, whichever comes first.

- Tie breaker: Win/Loss Head to Head
- Total Points in Round Robin Play

BLIND DRAW SINGLE ELIMINATION CHAMPIONSHIP:

24 teams placed in brackets by a blind draw will play to determine an overall champion.

GAME PLAY

DOUBLES PLAY - Team A competes against Team B; each team is comprised of two people.

1. Teams will stay in their designated lane for the whole match. Partners stand at opposite corn hole boxes on the same side facing each other.
2. A coin flip or Rock, Paper, Scissors will determine which team shall go first and from which side they will pitch from.
3. The team who has honors will begin play by one of the partners throwing a cornhole bag at the opposite corn hole board.
4. Players at the headboard will alternate pitching bags until each player has pitched all four of his/her bags.
5. Players at the footboard will take score and resume pitching back to the other board.
6. The round is completed when both players pitching from the headboard pitch all four bags; the next round is completed when the remaining players pitching from the footboard pitch all four bags.
7. Team with highest score has honors to throw first in next round.
8. Play continues until one team reaches 21 points or 20 minutes, whichever comes first using "cancel out" scoring (see scoring).

CORNHOLE FOULS:

- A foul bag is any bag pitched when the player has made contact with or crossed over the foul line, or started or stepped completely outside the pitcher's box before the bag is released.
- Any bag that hits the ground and ends up on the board.
- Any bag not delivered within the 20-second time limit.
- A player goes out of turn.
- A bag pitched from a different pitcher's box than the first bag.
- Any bag removed from the board before scoring has been agreed upon for that bag.

SCORING:

Bag In-The-Count (Woody): Any bag which comes to rest anywhere on top of the board. Each is worth one (1) point.

Bag In-The-Hole (Cornhole): Any bag which is thrown through the hole or knocked through the hole by another bag. Each is worth three (3) points.

Foul Bags - Refers to any bag that has not been determined as Bag In- The-Count or Bag In-The-Hole or was designated a foul bag as the result of rules violation. A foul bag will be removed from the board immediately.

Scoring for this tournament will be "cancellation" scoring. In cancellation scoring, the points of one player cancel out the points of their opponent. Using this method, only one player/team can score in each round. (Ex. If team one scores 6 points and team two scores 4 points, team one will earn 2 points for that round).
